James 3:13-18 states:

“Who is wise and understanding among you? Let him show by good conduct that his works are done in the meekness of wisdom. But if you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth. This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, demonic. For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there. But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy. Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.”

Today there is no lack for knowledge or information, we are living in a connected digital world and every information is in our fingertips. Knowledge is readily available to everyone, but wisdom seems nonexistent. As we look around and see what is happening, this is evident. Knowledge is just accumulation of information, facts and data, but wisdom is the ability to apply what we learned and put them into practice in our real-life situations and at times of need, that is decision making. James highlights two sources of wisdom:

- * one he calls as the wisdom of this world - that is rooted in the secular, in the sensual and even in the satanic philosophies and principles; this wisdom only brings envy, evil, confusion, selfishness and disaster.
- * the real wisdom is heavenly and is from “above”, from God, from the Word of God, and this kind of wisdom is the God-given ability to perceive the true nature of the circumstances and to apply HIS will to the issue at hand.

Proverbs 9:10 teaches us:

“The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

Knowing the Lord Jesus Christ in an intimate and personal way gives us the authority as Child of God, and access to the Heavenly wisdom. Solomon in his teen years, was burdened with greater responsibility - as king of Israel he had to maintain the level of kingship as his father David, who was a great warrior, dynamic and successful leader. When he was young, God asked him **“What shall I give you?”** (1 Kings 3:5) Solomon had the right answer, and his priorities were in the right order, 1 Kings 3:9 **“Therefore give to Your servant an understanding heart to judge Your people, that I may discern between good and evil. For who is able to judge this great people of Yours?”**

Solomon desired the wisdom that comes from above, not the wisdom from this world, so he asked God for wisdom. Solomon recognized that his greatest need is wisdom to make the right decisions. We know God granted what he asked and in addition gave riches and honor. 1 Kings 3:11-13 **“Then God said to him: “Because you have asked this thing, and have not asked long life for yourself, nor have asked riches for yourself, nor have asked the life of your enemies, but have asked for yourself understanding to discern justice, behold, I have done according to your words; see, I have given you a wise and understanding heart, so that there has not been anyone like you before you, nor shall any like you arise after you. And I have also given you what you have not asked: both riches and honor, so that there shall not be anyone like you among the kings all your days.”**

Today we are in need of this wisdom, and the wisdom of Heaven is God's gift to us, His children. The only requirement is that we ask God for it. James 1:5 **If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.** So what will you ask today? If we ask Jesus, He will give us the wisdom and understanding heart - ability to make right decisions. Do you remember to pray to Jesus and seek HIS will, plan and purpose before you make a decision in your life? Our God is faithful, and He will answer our prayers, like He did for Solomon!!

DID YOU KNOW?



God then commanded him to leave and hide by Brook Cherith. Elijah traveled far to reach Brook Cherith and he was super tired when he reached it. He slept near the brook in the night and when he woke up, he saw ravens there with his breakfast. The ravens brought him bread and meat. c. *First Time*


STOREHOUSE OF THE HEART

In this month's message we are going to see three ways His people are blessed when the heavens are open. Why does God want to open up the heavens over us?

God wants to change all the debts that we may have in our life. He desires to bless all the works of our hands. Through this month's promise, God wants to open up the heavens and let blessings rain over us. He wants to open the doors of heaven's storehouse for us. When our Heavenly Father opens the heavens for us then every blessing that is spoken in this verse will come to pass in our lives. There are many instances in the Bible where we see that the heavens were opened; when Jesus took His baptism, the heavens opened and a dove descended from the heavens (Luke 3:21-22). When Jesus took His disciples on the mount of transfiguration there was a loud voice (Matthew 17:5) that came from heaven. Whenever God opens up the windows of heaven there is a change that comes about in the lives of His children. This change happens in the spiritual realm and the physical realm. There are many differences between an open heaven and one that is closed.

To Send the Rain

“Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain; and it did not rain on the land for three years and six months. And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth produced its fruit.”

James 5:17&18 (NKJV)

In this verse we see that when the heavens open, rain comes down. This scripture says the heaven gave rain and the earth produced crops. If we want the ground beneath us to bear fruit and produce crops then the heavens must first open over us and pour out rain. Our promise verse (Deuteronomy 28:12) also says that He is a God who opens the heavens and lets it rain at the right season. During the time of Elijah there was

a certain season when God had shut the heavens and stopped the rain.

“And Elijah the Tishbite, of the inhabitants of Gilead, said to Ahab, “As the LORD God of Israel lives, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, except at my word.”

1 Kings 17:1 (NKJV)

In this verse we see that God looks at Elijah and says there will not be any rain. During this time God made a provision for Elijah in the midst of the famine. God asked Elijah to hide at the Brook Cherith and provided him water to drink and commanded the ravens to bring him food (1 Kings 17:3&4). After the brook dried, God took him to the house of a widow who lived in Zarephath and made provision for him there. In Elijah's life he experienced no lack in the midst of the drought. The man of God was well taken care of

by God even during the time of drought. Then God tells Elijah: **“And it came to pass after many days that the word of the LORD came to Elijah, in the third year, saying, “Go, present yourself to Ahab, and I will send rain on the earth.” I Kings 18:1 (NKJV)**

Through Elijah, God sends a word that He is going to open the heavens and send rain in the future. Rain that had been hindered for three years will return to the land.

This is going to be a month where God is going to remove every obstruction to make way for the blessing. This is why God wants to open up the heaven over your life. When God opens up the heavens and pours out rain, He is taking the land into a new dimension of blessings; in the same way God is going to take you into a new season. When God withheld the rain it was not permanent, it was only temporary. When Elijah goes to see Ahab, he says, **“Is that you, O troubler of Israel?” (I Kings 18:17).** Elijah goes

to meet Ahab because God wanted him to tell Ahab that it is going to rain. But Ahab was angry with Elijah. Ahab thought it was because of Elijah that there was famine in the land, so he had sent his armies into the land to find and arrest Elijah. The moment Ahab saw Elijah he called him the troubler of Israel. But Elijah

you take a stand for Him. If the Lord is God follow Him with all your heart despite the situation.

The second reason why the heavens were shut was because there was an altar of the Lord that was broken down (I Kings 18:30). The people did not give importance to the sacrifices

that they had to make for God on the altar. There was no thought in the minds of the people to repair the broken altar. They had completely rejected God. Even in our life we need to give everything

to God, it all belongs to Him. Our lives need to be like an altar in the presence of God. And on that altar, we need to bring forth a sacrifice of praise and worship to God. As we continue to praise and worship Him, the heavens will open over us.

“When the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD...that the house, the house of the LORD, was filled with a cloud;”

2 Chronicles 7:1 (NKJV)

When Solomon dedicated the temple of God, Solomon and all the Israelites praised God with one voice, and the glory of the Lord filled the temple of God. So commit yourself to repair the altar and praise the Lord always.

Elijah faced many challenges but God was with Elijah and because God was with him He sent fire from the heavens and revealed that the Lord alone is God. The Bible tells us that after this victory Elijah went up the mountain and started to pray for rain. He bowed down on the ground, and put his face between his knees, (I Kings 18:42) and prayed. Elijah had to humble himself before the Lord. We too need to humble ourselves

God is ready to open the heavens and pour out rain

responded:

“...“I have not troubled Israel, but you and your father's house have, in that you have forsaken the commandments of the LORD and have followed the Baals.”

I Kings 18:18 (NKJV)

God is ready to open the heavens and pour out rain but before that He desires to set right a few things. God wants to reveal the reason for shutting the heavens in our life as well. Ahab says that there has been no rain because of the prophet of God. But God speaks through His prophet and tells Ahab and the people that it is because they followed Baal.

“And Elijah came to all the people, and said, “How long will you falter between two opinions? If the LORD is God, follow Him; but if Baal, follow him.” But the people answered him not a word.”

I Kings 18:21 (NKJV)

The first reason that the heavens were closed was because the people were wavering in their faith; sometimes they followed God and at other times they followed Baal. They were a people who had not made a commitment to the Lord. God wants

before the Lord and submit to His ways.

Elijah started to pray and sent his servant to go check the heavens to see if he could see clouds. Before Elijah began to pray he had told Ahab, "Go up, eat and drink; for there is the sound of abundance of rain." (1 Kings 18:41). Elijah had heard the sound but began to pray so he could see the rain. The first time the servant went out he saw nothing; Elijah tells him to go back seven times. Then Elijah continued to pray. Like Elijah, God is asking you to pray without ceasing, until you see the rain.

Maybe you have seen a lot of discouragement. Like the servant who could not see anything the first couple of times, you are also seeing nothing. But God changed all the disappointing news and brought about a cloud the shape of a hand, He will do the same for you. When the heavens open up all the disappointment in your life will change, you will receive answers to your prayers, and see the showers of blessing in your life.

"I will make them and the places all around My hill a blessing; and I will cause showers to come down in their season; there shall be showers of blessing." Ezekiel 34:26 (NKJV)

To send the bread

Yet He had commanded the clouds above, And opened the doors of heaven, Had rained down manna on them to eat, And given them of the bread of heaven. Men ate angels' food;

He sent them food to the full.

Psalm 78:23-25 (NKJV)

The Bible tells us that the Lord opened up the heavens and sent Manna, the food that Angels ate. He sent it so that the people could eat and lack nothing.

"And the children of Israel said to them, 'Oh, that we had died by the hand of the LORD in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the pots of meat and when we ate bread to the full! For you have brought us out into this wilderness to kill this whole assembly with hunger!'"

Exodus 16:3 (NKJV)

The people murmured that they had abundance in Egypt where they were slaves but in the wilderness they lacked food. So God said to Moses:

"... 'Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you. And the people shall go out and gather a certain quota every day, that I may test them, whether they will walk in My law or not.'"

Exodus 16:4 (NKJV)

God could have made grains to sprout on the land so people could eat, but God wanted to open the heaven for His people and send food from his storehouse. His storehouse is never empty and the blessings continuously flow. God provided food to His people in a perfect manner. God loved His people so much that He made a provision for them in the wilderness. When God provided food to meet the needs of murmuring people in such a perfect manner, how much more will He do for you when you praise Him

continuously? Keep praising God, do not be discouraged and God will open up the heavens for you.

Like the manna that came for the Israelites every morning, in the New Testament time, God wants to open up the heavens and send His word to you each day as the bread.

"... My word be that goes forth from My mouth;

It shall not return to Me void,

But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it."

Isaiah 55:11 (NKJV)

Here we see that God's word goes to accomplish His will. God will send His word and accomplish the things that you can not do on your own.

To send the fire

In Acts 2 we read that the disciples gathered in the upper room. Suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house and tongues of fire sat on each of them that had gathered.

God wants to send a fire among us in this month. God wants to anoint each of us with His Holy Spirit. The lives of the disciples changed when they were anointed. The Holy Spirit is for our deliverance. Where the Spirit of the Lord is there is freedom and deliverance (2 Corinthians 3:17). Ask God for an anointing each day. Because His anointing will break every yoke, bondage and bring about a strength in your life.
