- **Family Camp from August 1 to August 3, 2019 at Alhatti Christian Center, Idyllwild, CA.**



PERSEVERANCE

TEEN'S PAGE - PREMKUMAR THOMAS AUGUSTINE

Do you know Thomas Alva Edison? He is known as an esteemed inventor— he is the inventor of light bulbs which replaced fires and other light sources. Edison was one of the most persevering people in history! He never gave up! He failed many times but he never stopped pursuing his dream, he learned from his mistakes and tried again and again till his dreams become reality!

In the dictionary, perseverance is defined as “steadfastness in doing something despite difficulty or delay in achieving success.” So, if we exhibit perseverance, surely we will be blessed! In **James 1:12** we read, ***“Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.”***

1. Perseverance in our Faith: **James 5:11** states that ***“You have heard of the perseverance of Job and seen the end intended by the Lord—that the Lord is very compassionate and merciful.”***

Job persevered through some of the most difficult situations in life! Job was a faithful man, blameless and upright. He served God, feared God, and turned away from evil (Job 1:1). One day, Job was told by different servants that all his belongings and possessions, livestock and ten children had been killed or destroyed by natural disasters or thieves (Job 1:13-18). Despite all this, Job still praised God even in his sorrow. Next, Job was afflicted with painful boils from the sole of his foot to the crown of his head (Job 2:7), and yet he persevered and praised God. In his grieving and illness, Job’s friends came and sat with him. Despite the terrible advice they offered him, Job still praised God.

God showed His mercy on Job and restored his health and all his possessions, granting him twice as much as he had previously, more children and a long prosperous life. We see in **Job 42:12** that, ***“Now the Lord blessed the latter days of Job more than his beginning;”*** In Job’s life, he went through so much challenges, difficulties and pain, but he never gave up on his trust and hope in God! If you demonstrate your perseverance in faith in God, the Lord will surely show you His compassion and mercy to you.

2. Perseverance in our Prayer: In *Luke 18:7* Jesus tells us that, *“shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them?”*

In Luke 18:1-8, we read about the “Parable of the Persistent Widow”. It is a perfect example of perseverance in prayer that we can follow. It details how a widow goes before a Judge, who doesn’t fear God or man. She pleads with the Judge for justice from her adversary. The Judge never heard her cry, and ignored her for long time. But, she continually pleaded with him for her justice. After a while, the Judge (even though he didn’t fear God or man) avenged her against her adversary. This parable highlights us how God will avenge his children—believers—even more swiftly than an earthly judge. When we continually cry out to God, He hears us. We should persistently plead with God, praying and persevering in faith, until we get His rewards. Jesus hears our prayers and listens to His children.

3. Perseverance in our Suffering for Christ: Apostle Paul declares in *Romans 5:3* that, *“we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance;”* Paul is the ultimate example of perseverance in suffering for Christ. Paul, formerly known as Saul, was a huge persecutor of Christians. He constantly threw them in jail or had them killed. But, he had a dramatic encounter with Jesus and was transformed to be a new creature. When Paul became a Christian, he did remarkable things for the kingdom. He was a church planter and mentor to Timothy, and he became a most influential writers of the Bible! He wrote 13 books of the New Testament! No one has a better conversion story, going from killing Christians to becoming Paul, one who was on fire for the Lord!

Paul faced many trials and persecutions in his life, and Paul details this in 2 Corinthians 11:23-33. He was imprisoned repeatedly, flogged, exposed to death again and again, received 39 lashes for five times, beaten with rods three times, pelted with stones, shipwrecked three times, in many perils, in weariness and toil, in sleeplessness often, in hunger and thirst, in fasting often, in cold and nakedness and so on! And yet, Paul calls such sufferings as light and momentary in 2 Corinthians 4:17-18 - For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

Paul knew that no matter how much it hurts now, it was nothing as compared to the hope and healing that he would experience for eternity in the presence of his Savior.

Here, I want to remind you of three key points:

- **Perseverance in faith and trust in God’s plan will result in blessings and joy!**
- **Perseverance in prayer will bring solutions to our problems!**
- **Perseverance in suffering for Christ will bring glory to our Lord Jesus Christ, and make us living advertisements for Christ!**

Let us ask Jesus to give us grace to persevere in our faith, prayer and sufferings! You know that Jesus persevered for you, and He’s there to encourage you as you persevere for Him.

“You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised.” - Hebrews 10:36

Although he was persecuted many times, Paul continued to do His ministry with Joy because of his love for God. Historians and Scholars believe that Paul was in prison when he wrote this above verse to the believers saying, rejoice! When we have a close relationship with God, we will know that God is with even during our trials, so we can be assured that He will help us. Bible says joy is the fruit of the Holy Spirit which comes as a result of our fellowship with God. Loving God will fill us with joy in His presence.



2. Trusting in God:

“And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.” - Romans 8:28



God’s word is unchangeable, this is our hope in times of trouble that ALL things work together for good when we love God and are called according to His purpose. 

PROMISE MESSAGE

“Surely blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply you.” Hebrews 6:14

It is God’s desire to increase us. In the bible we read that God has blessed many of His servants to multiply and increase. Although we all go through times of insufficiency or feel like we are walking through a wilderness in our personal lives, it is not God’s will for us to dwell in it too long. Today let us see who all received this promise from God and how we also can inherit it.

1. Those who obey the call of God:

Now the Lord had said to Abram: “Get out of your country, from your family and from your father’s house, to a land that I will show you.” - Genesis 12:1



In the above verse we see how Abraham was called by God. God called Abraham to leave the country he was dwelling in and travel to the place that God will show him; when he started the journey God did not tell Abraham where he needs to go. This was not easy but Abraham was willing to take a step of

faith and chose to obey God's call. (Genesis 12:4). In Acts 7:5 we read God gave him no inheritance in it, not even enough to set his foot on. But even when Abraham had no child, He promised to give it to him for a possession, and to his descendants after him. After receiving God's promise, Abraham built an altar for the Lord. God continued to bless and increase him so much that the land was not able to provide for their flocks and herds. (Genesis 13:5). He was also rich in silver and gold yet he did not have a child, God visited Abraham again and again assuring him to make his descendants as stars of the sky and as sand of the sea shore. According to this promise He gave him Isaac and through him increased his descendants.

When Abraham obeyed the call of God He saw an increase even in a hopeless situation. Even in our lives each one of us have a call of God for different purposes. Sometimes we could face challenges when we try to answer God's call and obey Him but God is faithful to fulfill his promises. I want to encourage you to respond to His call even if it seems difficult, God will reward you abundantly.

“He who calls you is faithful, who also will do it.” - 1 Thessalonians 5:24

2. Those who offer to God:

And He said, “Do not lay your hand on the lad, or do anything to him; for now I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your son, your only son, from Me.”
Genesis 22:12




Abraham not only obeyed the call of God but was also willing to offer anything in obedience to God. Abraham waited for a long time to receive the son that God had promised but when the lad was young, God asked him to offer him as a sacrifice. Without holding back, Abraham prepared to offer his son in obedience to God. When God saw his faith, God called him from heaven and stopped him.

He said: *“By Myself I have sworn, says the Lord, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only son blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply your descendants as the stars of the heaven and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies.”* (Genesis 22:16, 17). Even though Abraham was already blessed so much, God added more because he was willing to give.

Similarly, in 1 Kings 17: 9 Word of God came to Elijah asking him to go to Sidon, to a widow named Zarephath. Approaching the widow, Elijah realized she was going through a lack. She was preparing the last meal for herself and her son yet because she was willing to offer the last meal to His servant who was sent by God to her, God miraculously met all her needs. Her supplies lasted until the famine was over!

3. Those who are oppressed:

“But the more they were oppressed, the more they multiplied and spread; so the Egyptians came to dread the Israelites.” - Exodus 1:12



Israelites were descendants of Abraham, God’s chosen people. God had promised Abraham to make his descendants as stars of the sky and sand of the sea shore and give the land he was dwelling in as an inheritance to them. After the time of Joseph, Israelites who were dwelling in Egypt were oppressed by the Pharaoh. However because of God’s promise and blessing to Abraham they were greatly multiply in midst of their oppression and this eventually caused them to move toward God’s Promised Land! Even in our lives, when we feel oppressed, God will turn it for our good. When we cry out to the Lord, He will hear us and deliver us.

As children of God when we obey, follow and offer our best to God, we will also see God’s faithfulness and God’s increase in our own lives. I pray that God will help you to know His call for your life and enable you to inherit His promises as you enter into this new month.


