Entry Point

It's with great pleasure connecting with you all through this newsletter, wishing you great success in this new academic year. Many of you feel so excited to go back to school / college after long vacation, there may be various reasons like friends, new class room and more importantly about the place. As soon as we get closer to school or college entrance we will be struck by good memories and what is in the plan for this year. The Entry Point always has significance in our life. Let see what Jesus says about the Entry Point:

“The lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light.” - Matthew 6:22

Here Jesus signifies Eye as Entry Point and referred to it as lamp and giving a way to light up the body by having good eyes or to set right our entry point.

In our logical way of thinking, an eye takes in light, rather than giving off light so we may wonder at the meaning of these verses. Jesus' description of the eye should not be viewed merely as physical eye, but also to the moral or ethical character of a person aligned with spirit of God.

We can see from Bible, eye is often used as a comparison either leads to an understanding or ignorance. Job wrote that his eyes had grown dim with sorrow (Job 17:7), here it talks about the reflection of Job's emotions. The Bible describes a proud man as having haughty eyes (Proverbs 6:17) and a humble man as having downcast eyes (Job 22:29). These verses show the way of seeing one another and is closely connected to the heart.

“But if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in you is darkness, how great is that darkness!” - Matthew 6:23

We see David as a renowned warrior and anointed one, but if you read the scripture in 2 Samuel Chapter 11 how his eyes led to destruction and causing him to sin and put him on darkness.

The reference says “David happened to see” so its not planned or intentional, but an accident. The eyes are an entry point to the mind and whatever one’s mind continually thinks upon; his heart will conceive, and he/she will eventually do. The world is filled with lot of ungodly things, whether you see it accidentally or incidentally, do not give way for your mind and heart to dwell in it rather submit your thoughts to God and your actions, be led by his word.

The other set of eyes are of moral/ethical character, we see in Matthew 20, Jesus told the parable of the workers in the vineyard. The owner went out to hire people work in the vineyard, some had agreed to work from 6 am to 6 pm for a denarius. Master again went out and hired some at 9 am, noon and finally at 5 pm. When the day was done at 6 pm he paid all the workers the same thing—a denarius. In other words, he was lavishly generous to those who worked only one hour, and he paid the agreed amount to those who worked twelve hours.

“And when they had received it, they complained against the landowner, 12 saying, ‘These last men have worked only one hour, and you made them equal to us who have borne the burden and the heat of the day.’ - Matthew 20:11-12

The men who worked all day “grumbled at the master of the house”. They were angry that those who worked so little were paid so much. It’s a greedy or unethical eye that cannot see the beauty of grace. It cannot see the brightness of generosity. It cannot see unexpected blessing to others as a precious treasure. It is an eye that is blind to what is truly beautiful and bright and precious and God-like. It sees money and material reward as more to be desired than a beautiful display of free, gracious, God-like generosity.

The worldly eye may take us through logical reasoning and would convict it’s not “fair”, Jesus did not count the number of sins each of us have done, He just lay down His life for each and every one. It’s by His Grace we are saved. So if you are emotionally drawn more by material things than by Christ, pray that God would give you a good eye and awaken you from the blindness.

Last one is spiritual eye, we can read in 2 Kings 6, Prophet Elisha was surrounded by Syrian army and his servant was afraid of the terror that fall on them as they came to kill them.

“Don’t be afraid,” Elisha answered. “There are more troops on our side than on theirs.” 17 Then he prayed, “LORD, please help him to see.” And the LORD let the servant see that the hill was covered with fiery horses and flaming chariots all around Elisha.” - 2 Kings 6:16-17

Elisha was able to see LORD’s army, however the servant did not know the reason being afraid of the enemy. Hence the answer to him starts with “Don’t’ be Afraid”. In our daily life we get afraid of many things and screaming for help. But one thing we need to do is pray, here Elisha prayed to the LORD to help him see. Even in our challenging situation where our physical or moral/ethical eye cannot see, the spiritual eye can see the LORD’s protection around us.

Be strong, set your entry point clear and aligned with Jesus. He will guard and lead you throughout this month of September.



COMPASSIONATE HEART

I greet you all in the name of Jesus Christ. I thank God for this opportunity to connect with you through this newsletter each month. Today I would like to share with you on the topic: 'having a compassionate heart'. In the gospels, we can read in several places that Jesus was moved with Compassion, let us meditate on few of these passages from the bible and learn from it.

1. Compassion on an individual person:

Now a leper came to Him, imploring Him, kneeling down to Him and saying to Him, "If You are willing, You can make me clean." Then Jesus, moved with compassion, stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed." As soon as He had spoken, immediately the leprosy left him, and he was cleansed.
Mark 1:40-42

In olden days, lepers were considered as outcasts and untouchable, yet Jesus was moved with compassion and touched him and spoke to him saying "I am willing; be cleansed." Similarly, even in times of our needs and times of pain, when we cry out to God, He is moved with compassion and reaches out to help us. Jesus is compassionate towards us that He is willing to cleanse us even today. As we keep reading further, we can see that it was not only for this leper that Jesus moved with compassion, there were many more people who were touched by His love. In Matthew 20:29-34, there were 2 blind men who cried out to Jesus as He was passing them, even though the multitudes warned them to stay quiet, Jesus heeded to their cry and opened their eyes. Not only to those who called to Him, Jesus was moved with compassion when He witnessed the tears of a widow who lost her son.

When the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her and said to her, "Do not weep." Then He came and touched the open coffin, and those who carried him stood still. And He said, "Young man, I say to you, arise." So, he who was dead sat up and began to speak. And He presented him to his mother. - Luke 7:13-15

2. Compassion on the multitude:

When Jesus heard it, He departed from there by boat to a deserted place by Himself. But when the multitudes heard it, they followed Him on foot from the cities. And when Jesus went out, He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick. - Matthew 14:13,14

Here we see that Jesus was going to a deserted place trying to be away from the crowds however seeing the multitudes following Him on foot for many surrounding cities, He was moved with compassion and healed them. Nonetheless they stayed there three days to listen to His words and witnessing miracles. When it was time for the people to leave, Jesus knew they have had nothing to eat for three days so He was compassionate to provide them with food before they started their journey.



“I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now continued with Me three days and have nothing to eat. And if I send them away hungry to their own houses, they will faint on the way; for some of them have come from afar.” - Mark 8:2,3

In our lives too He is compassionate to meet our physical needs so that we can continue our journey for the LORD. In Mark 6: 34 we can see Jesus, when He came out, saw a great multitude and was moved with compassion for them, because they were like sheep not having a shepherd. He cares for our spiritual needs too.

Today we meditated on few bible verses showing God’s compassion on His people, be it one person or a multitude. Jesus moved with compassion to meet the needs of people both physical needs as well as spiritual needs. As His disciples we ought to be compassionate towards others, this is God’s desire for us as Christians. When we have a compassionate heart, God will use us to touch lives for His glory.

“Finally, all of you be of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, be tenderhearted, be courteous; not returning evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary blessing, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing.” - 1 Peter 3:8,9

Deuteronomy 33:29 (NKJV)**


*Happy are you, O Israel! Who is like you, a people saved by the Lord,
The shield of your help and the sword of your majesty!.. - Deuteronomy 33:29*

Here we see how Moses blesses the people of Israel saying “Happy are you, O Israel! Who is like you, a people saved by the Lord”; We see that Israel is a nation chosen by God as it also says in Psalm 135:4 “For the Lord has chosen Jacob for Himself, Israel for His special treasure”; Further in 1 Peter 2:9 we can also see that God calls us a chosen generation. What does Israel signify? Israelites are God’s chosen people, although we are not people of Israel in flesh, in Spirit through faith in Jesus we are also God’s chosen people partaking in the God’s promises to Israel. (Galatians 3:14). We see that People of Israel are called “blessed” (Numbers 22:12). God was pleased to bless the people of Israel (Numbers 24:1). With many such promises God has several blessings for His people, let us see some of these promises today and how we can inherit them.

1. His Increase:

And God said to him, “Your name is Jacob; your name shall not be called Jacob anymore, but Israel shall be your name.” So, He called his name Israel. Also God said to him: “I am God Almighty. Be fruitful and multiply; a nation and a company of nations shall proceed from you, and kings shall come from your body. Genesis 35:10-11

God gives Jacob a new name, saying he will be called “Israel” at the same time God also promised him that he will be fruitful and multiply. This is a promise of multiplication saying kings shall come from your body! In Genesis 28:3,4 we read Isaac blessing Jacob with a similar promise that Lord Almighty will multiply you and give you the blessings of Abraham. Looking at the promises to Abraham, we can see that God promised to give him the land he was dwelling and that his descendants will be as dust of the earth (Genesis 13:14-16). In Genesis 15 we see God promised Abraham that his descendants will be as stars, that could not be numbered. God continued to bless Jacob with these same promises thus fulfilling His word to Abraham. Even when the people of Israel were in Egypt oppressed by their enemy, they



continued to multiply greatly (Exodus 1:10). After God delivered them out of Egypt, Moses reminds them God's faithfulness and blesses them according to the same promise of increase! (Deuteronomy 1:10,11). It is God's will to increase His people, as the LORD has been fulfilling this promise in Israel. He will do the same in your lives too so you will see an increase as well.

2. His Strength:

God brings them out of Egypt; He has strength like a wild ox. Numbers 23:22

Another blessing that Israel has from the LORD "His strength", God promised them a strength like a wild ox. In Psalms 18:32 David says "It is God who arms me with strength, And makes my way perfect." He gave this kind of strength to David because he had to run through the troops and leap over the wall (Psalms 18:29). In our lives too we often require strength to leap over some situations we are in and to run through circumstances that cause fear and threaten to defeat us. For this God gives His strength to His people. In Numbers 23: 24 God says that His people will lift themselves like a young lion that will not lie down until it devours its prey. This talks about determination and boldness that God's people can have because of His strength. 2 Samuel 3:1 we read David grew stronger and stronger. It is God's will to increase you from strength to strength. With God's strength you will overcome the challenges you face. Fear not the LORD is with you to strengthen you and give you victory.



3. His Peace:

Yes, may you see your children's children. Peace be upon Israel! Psalms 128:6



God promised peace for His people, Israel. It is God's desire for us to live in peace. In 2 Chronicles 14:7 we read "...we have sought Him, and He has given us rest on every side." So, they built and prospered. When God destroyed their enemies and gave them rest, God's people were able to make progress in their work and prosper. But two verses later we read, in 2 Chronicles 14:9 we see that Ethiopians came against them and Israelites cried out to the Lord for His help. God heard their cry and struck their enemies and gave them rest all around (2 chronicles 15:15). Even today, when the enemy comes against us, we often lose our peace and go into a state of unrest and fear but according to His promise God will make your enemies submit to you and you shall tread on their high places (Deuteronomy 33:29). God will lift you above your enemies and they will submit to you. You will overcome and destroy the enemies that are disturbing your peace! You will dispossess nations that are greater than you and every place your sole of your foot tread will be yours. No man shall be able to stand against you (Deuteronomy 11: 23-25). According to God's promise those who come against you one way will flee before you seven ways (Deuteronomy 28:7).

Here we saw three kinds of blessing that God desires for you and me; to increase, to have strength and peace. But He expects two things from us:

1. We should love Him.

For if you carefully keep all these commandments which I command you to do—to love the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways, and to hold fast to Him. Deuteronomy 11:22

2. We must heed God's voice.

And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the Lord your God. Deuteronomy 28:2

By doing these two things we can inherit and enjoy God's blessings in our lives. Let the Lord bless you according to this promise and keep you in Him throughout this month of September.

RIGHT CHOICES

In the garden of Eden, everything was perfect! God created Adam and Eve and instructed them not to eat from the “Tree of Knowledge of good and Evil.” But the serpent (the devil) told Eve that it was a right thing for her to eat the fruit and become like God, knowing good and evil. The fruit looked good in the sight of Eve and she ate it and shared it with Adam. Adam and Eve’s wrong choice brought sin and death in this world. God always lets us choose between good and evil.

Chase Better Things: Like reading your Bible, hanging out with good friends, going to church and obeying your parents. As the bible says in 1 Corinthians 15:33 “Do not be deceived: Evil company corrupts good habits.”

Pray about it: Ask Jesus to help you in such situation, Jesus will help you to overcome temptation and give you the courage to make right choices. Hebrews 2:18 says “For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted.”


