“He will feed His flock like a shepherd; He will gather the lambs with His arm, And carry them in His bosom, and gently lead those who are with young.” - Isaiah 40:11

Has anyone ever said something unkind to you or about you? I think we all have had that experience. Anytime you felt someone's words caused pain to you? Words do hurt us. Vicious and cunning slander or malicious gossip can be difficult to bear. Do you know, many friendships have been shattered because of cruel words? When the enemy hurts us with words, how do we respond? Sometimes we get angry, we get discouraged, we become bitter and this affects us. This is one of the deceiving tactics of the enemy.

Provoking and slanderous words:

Bible says in Psalm 64:3 that the enemy sharpen their tongue like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows—bitter words. The words of enemy are like sharpened sword, and are like arrows shot at you. In Bible we read about the life of Hannah. In 1 Samuel 1:6-7, it says “her rival also provoked her severely, to make her miserable” and “therefore she wept and did not eat”. Because she did not have a baby, she had to go through the pain of bitter words shot at her as arrows, and this happened to her every year.

Hannah's response: Bible says, Hannah went to the tabernacle of the Lord, and cried out to her Lord. She knew the attack of this provoking word can only be overcome by the power of God. God only can turn your sorrow into joy. In 1 Samuel 1:10, Bible says “Hannah was in bitterness of soul, and prayed to the Lord and wept in anguish”. After she prayed to the Lord in the Tabernacle, “she went her way and ate and her face was no longer sad” (1 Samuel 1:18). The enemy tries to keep us in sorrow, but we should understand the tactics of the enemy and not to react to his provoking and slanderous words. But, we should respond with prayer,

Psalm 55:11 says

“Evening and morning and at noon I will pray, and cry aloud, and He shall hear my voice.”

Threatening words:

In 1 Samuel 17, we read about the Philistine named Goliath who stood on the mountain top and looking at the army of Israel in the valley, and said to them, “Why have you come out to line up for battle? Am I not a Philistine, and you the servants of Saul? Choose a man for yourselves, and let him come down to me. If he is able to fight with me and kill me, then we will be your servants. But if I prevail against him and kill him, then you shall be our servants and serve us.” And the Philistine said, “I defy the armies of Israel this day; give me a man, that we may fight together.” Goliath did this for 40 days morning and evening. In verse 11, we see the whole Israel heard these words and were dismayed and afraid. Many times, we also encounter these kind of threatening words from the enemy. It could make us worry about our life, and put us in fear. When the Israel army heard these threatening words they reacted with fear. David also heard the same threatening words from Goliath.

David’s response: Bible says David did not fear, instead he was furious and said, “Who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living God?” (1 Samuel 17:26b). He was ready to face the threat directly! He put his trust upon God of Israel, who fights for us. In 1 Samuel 17:45-46, it’s recorded that “Then David said to the Philistine, *“You come to me with a sword, with a spear, and with a javelin. But I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. This day the Lord will deliver you into my hand, and I will strike you and take your head from you.”*” When the enemy shouts at you with threatening words and try to induce fear, don’t get into the trap of the enemy’s tactics. We should respond with courage declaring the Name of the Lord, trusting in His power, and remembering the great and mighty things He has done in our life and face the threat. Our God will give us the victory as He has given Goliath into the hands of David! Remember 2Timothy 1:7, “For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.”

Cunning and deceptive words:

In Nehemiah 6:1-2, we read Sanballat, Tobiah, Geshem, and the rest of the enemies contacted Nehemiah to ask him to meet at a neutral site. The implication is that they were seeking peace and wanted a meeting in order to accomplish this peace talk in a common place, in the plains of Ono. Probably it was politically wise for Nehemiah to make peace. In fact, as we see at the end of the chapter, many Jewish nobles were putting pressure on him to make peace (Nehemiah 6:16-19). It would not be a good political move to ignore the plea of the enemy to have a meeting. These words were deceptive and cunning to distract Nehemiah. The enemy camp sent the same messages five times! But in their hearts the enemies conspired against Nehemiah, and thought to do harm.

Nehemiah’s response: He discerned that they were trying to hurt him (Nehemiah 6:2), and Nehemiah, in response, said that he was doing a great project and could not go down. Discerning the lies, cunningness and deception of the enemy is very important for us as well. This is important for us to understand because Satan is always trying to deceive us. He is cunning, and he is father of lies; so we should know the word of God to discern the truth! 1 John 2:27 says, *“But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.”* The anointing of Holy Spirit will teach us the discernment.

Please remember, enemy will try to attack us, but we should not react in flesh, instead respond with wisdom given by the Holy Spirit like Hannah, Nehemiah and David.

Isaiah 51:7 says *“Do not fear the reproach of men, Nor be afraid of their insults.”*

So, Fear Not, God is with you!! Have a blessed month.

WINGS OF SAFETY



PROMISE MESSAGE

Prayer

***“... “Do not be afraid for your prayer is heard ...”
Luke 1:13 (NKJV)***

Our God is God who hears our prayer and He will answer and work according to our prayer. Our prayer will never go in vain. In the Bible many have prayed and have miraculously received answers from the Lord, we are going to see the prayer of a few people in this month's message.

1. Prayer of Zacharias

***“But the angel said to him, “Do not be afraid, Zacharias, for your prayer is heard; and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John.”
Luke 1:13 (NKJV)***

When Zacharias the priest was burning incense in the temple, an angel of God appeared to him and gave him this news. The scripture tells us that Zacharias and his wife, Elizabeth, were righteous, walking in all the commandments and were blameless. They did not have any child of their own and they were well advanced in years (Luke 1:6-9). It was at such a time that an angel appeared to Zacharias and said, “Do not fear ... your prayer is heard”. What this shows is that even when all hope is lost, due to their old age, they received an answer because they prayed without giving up. The Bible does not say how long Zacharias and Elizabeth prayed but the scripture tells us they were old in age and this leads us to believe that they would have prayed for many years. The time for them to receive a child from the Lord had come and therefore Zacharias had an encounter the angel of the Lord. Through this child they would receive joy, gladness and

many will rejoice (Luke 1:14). Moreover, when the angel met Mary, the angel told her about Elizabeth's pregnancy and said, "...Now indeed, Elizabeth your relative has also conceived a son in her old age ... For with God nothing will be impossible" (Luke 1:36-37). In Zacharias and Elizabeth's life, their prayer brought them joy and gladness, made impossibilities into possibility and the answer they received became a blessing to many.

The Lord hears your prayer and because of your prayer you will receive happiness and joy and everything that seems impossible God will make possible. Therefore, do not be discouraged He is listening to your prayer.

***"I waited patiently for the LORD;
And He inclined to me,
And heard my cry."
Psalm 40:1 (NKJV)***

2. Prayer of Hannah

***"Then Eli answered and said, "Go in peace, and the God of Israel grant your petition which you have asked of Him."
1 Samuel 1:17 (NKJV)***



Eli, the priest, blessed Hannah in this way. This Hannah was one who went through many sorrows. She had no child and because of this her rival provoked her. Hannah's husband, Elkanah, was a supportive and loving man but it did not remove her sorrow (1 Samuel 1:6-7). Therefore, Hannah went into the presence of the Lord, cried and petitioned the Lord. In her sorrow she made a vow to the Lord saying, "...if you will...give your maidservant a male child, then I will give him to the Lord...". When Eli saw that only her lips were moving he thought she was drunk and asked her to cease from drinking (1 Samuel 1: 14). Then Hannah responded, "...I am a woman of sorrowful spirit. I ...have poured out my soul before the Lord". After Hannah poured her heart in the Lord's presence – the scripture tells that after that she was no longer sorrowful (1 Samuel 1:18). God listened to Hannah who prayed pouring her heart out, He remembered her and blessed her with a child and she named him Samuel and when he was still young, she gave him back to Lord.

“For this child I prayed, and the LORD has granted me my petition which I asked of Him. Therefore I also have lent him to the LORD; as long as he lives he shall be lent to the LORD.” So they worshiped the LORD there.”
1 Samuel 1:27&28 (NKJV)

God who listens to your prayer will think of you and give to you that which you are asking. Your prayer will remove your sorrow and heaviness of your heart. Therefore, do not be discouraged, the God who answered Hannah’s prayer will answer your prayer too.

***“But certainly God has heard me;
He has attended to the voice of my prayer.”***
Psalms 66:19 (NKJV)

3. Prayer of Jonah

***And he said:
“I cried out to the LORD because of my affliction,
And He answered me.
“Out of the belly of Sheol I cried,
And You heard my voice.”***
Jonah 2:2 (NKJV)

Prophet Jonah was a man who went through a time of distress because he did not listen to God’s direction and went to Tarshish instead on Nineveh. When on the ship, the Lord sent a storm and caused Jonah to be tossed out of the ship in to the ocean. After that he was in the belly of a fish for 3 days and 3 nights (Jonah 1:17). During the days when he was in fish’s belly he went through affliction, his soul fainted and the waters surrounded and flooded him (Jonah 2: 5 & 7). At this time, he cried out to God and his prayer



went up to him (Jonah 2:7). God listened to Jonah’s prayer and directed the fish to spit Jonah on dry land. Although Jonah disobeyed the Lord’s guidance, God listened to his prayer and answered it. Sometime even in our life we may fail to do that which God has directed us to do, however when we call upon Him He does not turn aside but He remains a God who answers our prayer. Our God is a God full of compassion, gracious and abundant in mercy (Psalm 86:15). He will listen to our prayer, answer us and set and free from all affliction. Therefore, do not be discouraged.

Nor His mercy from me!”***
Psalms 66:20 (NKJV)

Let God alone bless this entire month for you and answer all your prayers. Do not be discouraged and keep praying.


