






- **Praise sets us Free**


As many of us are going through distress or anxiety due to the uncertainty that surrounds COVID19 and the govt shutdown, please remember that God is in control. Not only for this season but in all our situations, this is God's promise to us:

I will restore to you the years that the swarming locust has eaten... Joel 2:25

Joel prophesied these words to His people when Israel had been struck by disasters. The condition of the land during this time is written in the previous chapter: **The vine has dried up, And the fig tree has withered; The pomegranate tree, The palm tree also, And the apple tree—All the trees of the field are withered; Surely joy has withered away from the sons of men. Joel 1:12.**

There was no joy among the people. There was no harvest, so all the people and the priests were in distress not knowing what future holds. Yet God

encouraged His people sending them His word spoken by His prophet Joel. Similarly, in our lives too God is able to change our difficult situations, sickness or loses. There are two things we must do as God's people, to see His word come to pass in our personal lives and in this nation.



1. Return to God

*So rend your heart, and not your garments; Return to the Lord your God,
For He is gracious and merciful, Slow to anger, and of great kindness;
And He relents from doing harm. Joel 2:13*

In olden days, when people went through difficulties, they tear their garments and cry out in distress. In these words, God is calling out His people to rend their hearts and come to Him. Rending our hearts means being convicted in our hearts to turn away from every sin and wicked ways by confessing them before God. When people of Israel were taken as captives to Babylon, Daniel one day came to know that it was time for the fulfillment of God's promise to deliver His people. So, he rends his heart and cried out to God by confessing his sins and his people's sins and praying for God's mercy (Daniel 9: 1 – 20). God heard his prayers and answered him. In the same way God will answer our cry and help us, when we rend our hearts before Him. He is able to restore all that we have lost according to His word.

“To the Lord our God belong mercy and forgiveness, though we have rebelled against Him.” - Daniel 9: 9

2. Fasting and prayer

*Now, therefore,” says the Lord, “Turn to Me with all your heart,
With fasting, with weeping, and with mourning.” Joel 2:12*

Promise Message

BE STRONG

*“Say to those who are fearful-hearted,
“Be strong, do not fear!
Behold, your God will come with vengeance,
With the recompense of God;
He will come and save you.”
Isaiah 35:4 NKJV*

Many times, in our lives we go through anxious situations especially when we face uncertainty. When we don't know what the next step is or when we feel locked in a situation, we feel panicked and may go through anxiety. But during times like this, it is the will of God to give us the victory so we can keep moving forward in life. In the scripture we see many who go through similar situations, in this month's promise message we are going to see the path they went through and how God brought victory in their life.

1. Divine Provision

*“And it happened after this that Ben-Hadad king of Syria gathered all his army, and went up and besieged Samaria. And there was a great famine in Samaria; and indeed they besieged it until a donkey's head was sold for eighty shekels of silver, and one-fourth of a kab of dove droppings for five shekels of silver.”
2 Kings 6: 24-25 (NKJV)*

The scripture talks about a famine in the land of Samaria. How severe was the famine? It was so severe

that people were killing their own children and eating. At this time a woman approached the king, two women decided that they will take turns and eat their children. This woman killed her son but it when it was turn for the other woman to kill her son, she hid her son (2 Kings 6:28&29). The king was sad on hearing this and he tore his clothes, wore sackcloth and became angry with Prophet Elisha and with God (2 Kings 6: 30 & 33). Sometimes we too when we are anxious, we get upset with God. At that time word of the Lord came to Elisha that by this time tomorrow everything will change (2 Kings 7:1). The word that came from the Prophet seemed impossible, but our God is able to change things overnight. The king's officer who heard this did not believe and confessed negatively. Sometimes we too in our anxious situations confess negatively but we need to confess words of faith and believe in God's miracles.

Abraham also went through time of stress when God asked him to offer Isaac as a sacrifice (Genesis 22:2), but Abraham confessed positively. He tells the men that they will go to the mountain to worship and come back (Genesis 22:5) and when Isaac asked where is the lamb for sacrifice Abraham tells him God will provide (Genesis 22:8). According to the words of faith that Abraham confessed God protected Isaac and gave him back to Abraham.

To fulfill the word that God gave prophet Elisha, God uses four lepers (2 Kings 7:3). When the lepers went to the Syrian camp, the Lord made the Syrians hear the sound of horses, chariots – a great army and so the Syrians left everything and fled their camp (2 Kings 7: 6&7). The Syrians left so hastily that they left the road full of garments and weapons (2 Kings 7: 15). Israel went and plundered the Syrian camp (2 Kings 7:16) and because of this the prices went down and everybody was able to buy food and other goods again. Just like God's word came through prophet everything changed and the famine was over.

God is able to meet all your needs. He will reveal His will from heaven and change every situation in a miraculous way. Therefore, do not be discouraged.

***“God is not a man, that He should lie,
Nor a son of man, that He should repent.
Has He said, and will He not do?
Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?”
Numbers 23:19 (NKJV)***

2. Divine protection

***“And when the servant of the man of God arose early and went out, there was an army,
surrounding the city with horses and chariots. And his servant said to him, “Alas, my
master! What shall we do?”
2 Kings 6:15***

When Elisha's servant came out of the house and saw the Syrian army and chariots that surrounded them, he panicked. He asked, “What shall we do?” The Syrian king had heard about Elisha and sent his army to go and get him (2 Kings 6:13). But when the servant saw the army he panicked because he did not know what to do. Elisha tells his servant, “Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them.” (2 Kings 6:16). Then Elisha looked to God and said, “LORD, I pray, open his



eyes that he may see.” (2 Kings 6:17). Then God opened his eyes and he saw that the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha. When the servant saw the army of God then his anxiety left him. Many times, our eyes are closed and we are unable to see God’s divine protection and so we start panicking. You too maybe like Elisha’s servant, you may be panicked in a situation and you don’t know what to do next but God who has brought you thus far will carry you through. His army is kept for you. God wants to open our spiritual eyes. We need to see the God who sees us, and we need to know that God protects us divinely. Therefore, do not be discouraged.

***“Behold, He who keeps Israel
Shall neither slumber nor sleep.”
Psalm 121:4 (NKJV)***

3. Divine Peace

***“But He was in the stern, asleep on a pillow. And they awoke Him and said to Him,
“Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?”
Mark 4:38 (NKJV)***

When the disciples were on the boat with Jesus, all of a sudden, a storm hit the boat and the boat was tossed. The disciples feared and they started thinking that they were going to lose their life. Remember when the storm hit the boat, Jesus was in the boat but even then, they feared. In our life too, we know Jesus is with us but when something small rocks our life we begin to get fearful and start panicking. But God wants to remove the fear and anxiety in our life and give us peace. When Jesus woke up, He rebuked the wind and there was peace. After that Jesus looked at the disciples and asked, “Why are you so fearful? How is it that you have no faith?” (Mark 4:40). The disciples were astonished at how the wind and sea obeyed him (Mark 4:41). The word of Jesus will remove every fear and anxiety in your life. He will send His word for you and every turbulent situation will calm down. Your life may feel like it is being tossed but remember Jesus is in your boat He has all the power and control over your situation and so He will send His word and do mighty things for you also.

John 14:1 (NKJV)***




