The Fear of the Lord

“The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge” Proverbs 1:7

King Solomon summarize the whole book of proverbs in this verse. But what is it to Fear the Lord? Is it to be afraid of God? The word “fear” used in this phrase has a different meaning than what we use in worldly way. When we say we fear, we usually mean things scares us, terrifying and make us run away or hide from it. Here Solomon reference it to utmost respect, honor, reverence. In other words, true respect and reverence of the deepest kind for God is the beginning of wisdom.

When we started to fear the Lord, it implies that we started to know the Lord. Solomon records in Proverbs 9:10 as “And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.” Laying our foundation on the Lord and gaining understanding of the Holy One will help us to grow in our faith in God. As we start to know Him, we begin to fear, and as we fear Him more by obeying to His word and following His commandments, we get to know Him deeper.

When we think of wisdom, we might think of a smart person in our class or quickly reference to $E=mc^2$ or something like that. The Biblical definition of wisdom is much different. Psalms 111:10 says, “A good understanding have all those who do His commandments”. Also we can see in Proverbs 3:7 “Do not be wise in your own eyes;” We know the right thing to do based on worldly principles and rationalism but is that aligned to God’s ways or are we leaning on to our smartness / discernment. We need to constantly look back to word of God, ask for His guidance in making decisions and live / lead in God’s way which brings honor, glory and praise to His name.





King Solomon got crowned as king in his Teen age, we can see from his life though with the kingship he could've sought many things against his enemies or the riches. He feared the Lord and spoke, 1Kings 3:9 "Therefore give to Your servant an understanding heart to judge Your people, that I may discern between good and evil. For who is able to judge this great people of Yours?"

We can see in verse 10, the speech pleased the Lord. His thought was about how he can be true to God's people. He goes to the extent and called himself as little child, don't know how to go out or come in, he humbled himself before the Lord and fully rely on God's mercy, grace to fill him with the knowledge and wisdom to apply the knowledge.

The above verse is the promise that God has given us for this month. I would like to take you through the 2 parts that are in this verse.

1. We belong to God

A garden enclosed, Is my sister, my spouse... Song of Solomon 4:12

God looks at each of you and calls you as His sister, His spouse. By these words He says that we belong to Him, He desires to be our help and shelter at all times. You and I belong to Christ, Jesus knows those who are His. Several places in the bible, God says 'My' people, 'My' servant. In each of these verses we can see how zealous He is towards His people. In Isaiah 43:1 He says "...I have called you by your name; You are Mine." Because we belong to the Lord, He will perfect all that concerns us. He has said, whoever touches you, touches the apple of His eye. We are so precious to Him. In another verse God says, I will walk among you and be your God, and you shall be My people (Leviticus 26:12). We can see in the book of Songs of Solomon, the bride says "My beloved is mine and I am his". In the same way you can also say to God that He is yours. Today God wants to remind you of His relationship with you. You are loved by God; you belong to God. You are precious and special in His sight. How other people see you is not important but how God sees you

is only important. Today the Lord sees you as His own.

2. We have God's protection

*A garden enclosed, Is my sister, my spouse,
A spring shut up; A fountain sealed. Song of Solomon 4:12*

This verse shows us how the Lord has been protecting and keeping. He says “you are an enclosed garden, a spring shut up and a fountain that is sealed”- all these signify His protection. God desires our lives to be hedged and protected just like a garden that is fenced. Then our lives will be like a garden where the Lord walks around, a place where He will commune with you. 1. Mary

“Then the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.” - Luke 1:30 (NKJV)

When the angel met Mary, the scripture tells us that Mary was fearful but the angel told her not to fear for she has found favor with God. In another version the word ‘favor’ is described as ‘grace’. The first time when the angel greeted Mary, the angel said, “Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women!” (Luke 1:28). Mary realized that she will be called ‘blessed’ even though she was a lowly maidservant of the Lord, because she received the grace of God. There was a great change in Mary’s life because of this grace. God chose Mary to bring forth the Son of God, Jesus and because of this mighty thing that God did in her life, even today we read about Mary in the scriptures and she is remembered.



Bible tells us that we are all saved by grace. When we are saved by His grace our lives become a blessing. Just like how God fulfilled His purpose in the life of Mary He will fulfill His will and purpose in your life too. He has chosen you as an instrument in His hand so your life will be a blessing to many.

2. Noah

***“But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.”
Genesis 6:8 (NKJV)***

Noah was a man who found grace in the eyes of God. During the days of Noah, God saw that the wickedness of men was great on the earth (Genesis 6:5). The men were doing that which displeased and grieved God. God decided to destroy all men and beast in the earth yet the Noah found grace in the sight of God. 3. Moses

“For how then will it be known that Your people and I have found grace in Your sight, except You go with us? So we shall be separate, Your people and I, from all the people who are upon the face of the earth.” - Exodus 33:16 (NKJV)

Moses was a man who humbled himself and sought the Lord’s mercy and grace. He knew that it was only through the grace of God that he can know Him and His ways. In the above verse we can see that Moses knew that if the Lord showed them His grace, He will go before them. The people were stiff-necked and stubborn so Moses sought the Lord’s forgiveness and grace that would cover their iniquity and lead them in His ways. And so, the Lord answered Moses’ prayer.

“I will also do this thing that you have spoken; for you have found grace in My sight, and I know you by name.” - Exodus 33:17 (NKJV)

In the same way, when we humble ourselves and seek the Lord to show us His grace in our lives, He will answer us too.

***“But He gives more grace. Therefore, He says:
“God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble.” - James 4:6***

When we leave our pride and walk in humility, we will receive grace. The enemy is constantly trying to bring pride into our lives by using our family, our accomplishments, finances, our attributes, talents and knowledge. But we need to choose and make up our mind to be humble and walk in humility. When we do this God will give us more grace.



The grace of God will lift us up from our lowly place and make us blessed, as He did for Mary. The grace of God will bring His counsel, guidance and protection on our lives just as it was in the life of Noah. The grace of God will help us to know God and His ways as it was in the life of Moses. In times of our shortcoming and limitations, God’s grace is sufficient for us.

And He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.” - 2 Corinthians 12:9


"DO NOT BE AFRAID ONLY BELIEVE..." LÜKE 8:50






