Promise Message – June 2015

“Therefore do not worry about tomorrow..”.

Matthew 6:34 (NKJV)

Worry is not from God and so it is not the will of God for us to worry or to be anxious. That is why in this month God gives us this promise verse and tells us not to worry about our tomorrow. We *should not worry because...*

1. He Cares for you

The reason why we should not worry is because His word says He cares for us.

“casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.”

1 Peter 5:7 (NKJV)

Peter tells us in the above verse that Jesus cares for us. Nobody can care for us the way Jesus cares for us. When Christ cares for us He is the only one who can bring goodness in our life.

The scripture says that once when Jesus was nearing Jericho, a blind man heard that Jesus was passing by and he cried out, saying, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!” (Luke 18:38). The people around the blind man warned him to be quiet but Jesus asked that the man be brought to Him. Jesus then asked him, **“What want Me to do for you?”** and the blind man said he wanted his sight. Then Jesus said to him, “Receive your sight; your faith has made you well.”(Luke 18:42).

Many people who were around the blind man looked at him and discouraged him and warned him to be quiet (Luke 18:39). Many probably never respected him but Jesus Christ cared for him. Jesus was concerned, He inquired the blind man and healed him and met his need.

The same way may be no one cares or is concerned about you but Christ loves you, He respects and cares for you. Jesus Christ who enquired the need of the blind man and healed him will also ask and meet your needs.

do you

In John 5, we read about a man at the pool of Bethesda, who had an infirmity for thirty eight years. When Jesus saw him, the Bible says He knew that the man had an infirmity for a long time and so He asked him, **“Do you want to be made well?”** (John 5:5&6). After enquiring about him, Jesus tells the man to “Rise, take up your bed and walk” (John 5:8).

Maybe you too are worried about something you do not have just like the blind man was worried about the sight which he did not have or maybe you are in a difficulty for a long time just like the man who had an infirmity for 38 years, no matter what situation you are in, Jesus cares for you. **Therefore do not worry He will inquire and meet your need.**

2. He Provides for you

“Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?”

Matthew 6:26 (NKJV)

In Matthew 6 we not only read about how God provides for the birds but also the lilies and the grass. When our Heavenly Father can take care of the birds, the lilies and grass and provide for all their needs, how much more will He provide and care for you and therefore He looks at you and tells you not to worry.

“Then the Lord said to Moses, “Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you. And the people shall go out and gather a certain quota every day...”

Exodus 16:4 (NKJV)

In the above verse we see that God provides for His people, the Israelites with bread from heaven. No matter if the people collected too little or too much, God said they will always have sufficient (Exodus 16: 16-18). God provided manna for the Israelites for forty years (Exodus 16:35). God knew the need of His people and met them accordingly. Just like He provided daily food for the people of Israel He is able to meet your needs on a daily basis, He will provide for you accordingly. When the people were concerned about their thirst God turned the bitter waters sweet and provided for His people (Exodus 15:22-25). God provided food, water and clothing for His people and in the same way God is able to do the same for you.

“Your garments did not wear out on you, nor did your foot swell these forty years.”

Deuteronomy 8:4 (NKJV).

When God provides for you, He will provide the best for you, so do not worry. He is your Jehovah Jireh.

3. He Knows you

*".... For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things."
Matthew 6:32 (NKJV)*

He is Almighty God who knows your needs and so do not worry. In 1 Kings 17 we see that God tells Prophet Elijah to hide at the brook Cherith and Elijah obeyed. God knew that He had to provide for Elijah, so God asked the ravens to bring bread and meat for Elijah in the morning and evening (1 Kings 17:6). Elijah ate the bread and meat and drank from the brook. When the brook dried up God knew it and prepared a widow in Zarephath to provide for Elijah (1 Kings 17:9). God who knows Elijah and knows his every need, knows you too, therefore do not be worried.

God knows the path you are going through and He is an able and mighty God to meet all your needs.

In Luke 10 we read that the Lord appointed seventy servants/laborers and sent them out two by two. He knew the people He was sending, He cared for them and their needs but He told them not to carry a money bag, knapsack, or sandals.

*"...for the laborer is worthy of his wages."
Luke 10:7 (NKJV)*

If you are serving Him and doing what He ask you then He will meet all your needs, therefore don't be worried.

How to stop worrying

a.) DO NOT BE ANXIOUS

"Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;"

Philippians 4:6(NKJV)

b.) CHOOSE THE GOOD PART

"... Mary, who also sat at Jesus' feet and heard His word. But Martha was distracted with much serving,..... Jesus answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about many things. But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her."

Luke 10:39-42 (NKJV)

c.) SEEK HIS KINGDOM

"But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you."

Matthew 6:33 (NKJV)
