Greetings to you all in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. It feels like the year just began but it's already November. All through this year we have been meditating on the kind of heart that God desires to see in us. This month I would like to share about having a 'Clean Heart' before God. Let's see how we can have a clean heart.

Confession:

***“Create in me a clean heart, O God,
And renew a steadfast spirit within me.” - Psalms 51:10***



This is a famous Psalm written by David when he sinned against God. Despite knowing Bathsheba was married he committed sin with her. Although he knew it was wrong, he committed and tried to cover it by killing her husband during a battle at his command.

Later Nathan the prophet told David of God's disapproval and judgement for his act. Only after that did David turn to God in repentance. Confession of our sin is very important for us to be forgiven by God. When we confess our sins and truly repent from it, God is merciful to forgive us no matter how big our sin. We can read in Psalm 51 to see how he poured out his heart in grief before God. He said ***"Against You only, have I sinned, And done this evil in Your sight That You may be found just when You speak, And blameless when You judge."*** - Psalms 51:4". I want to encourage you to always remember that no matter how great our sin is, we can go before God and confess; He is faithful to cleanse us if we are willing to repent.

Just as David also describes the blessedness of the man to whom God imputes righteousness apart from works:

***"Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven,
And whose sins are covered; Blessed is the man to whom the Lord shall not impute sin."*** - Romans 4:6,7

In the above verse Paul describes and quotes David saying we receive God's righteousness in our hearts when we confess and believe that God is faithful and just to forgive our sins because of what Jesus bore on the cross for us. We are forgiven when we believe and trust God. We need to understand that no matter how hard we try we can't be cleansed without faith in God. Thus, it is not our works but God who helps us to be cleansed.

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." - 1 John 1:9

Refining God:

"For He is like a refiner's fire And like launderers' soap." - Malachi 3:2

How can we keep our hearts clean all the time, do you think it is possible? As we are living in the end times, we can see how the world around us is crumbling and rushing towards ungodliness. Days are coming when people will start calling things that are evil good and good as evil. When we are living in this generation, we need God's cleansing fire to continually reside inside of us like a refiner's fire. When we seek God's Holy Spirit,



He is able to cleanse us and make us as white as snow because of His Holy fire which is like a launderer's soap.

At one point, Jesus asked His disciples, ***“Who do men say that I am?” (Mark 8:27)***. A variety of responses followed – ***(Mark 8:28) So they answered, “John the Baptist; but some say, Elijah; and others, one of the prophets.”*** If you just ask the same question today, it would elicit a range of answers! Some would say Jesus was a philosopher, great moral influencer, great man worthy of emulation as model; others consider Him a fraud, liar, rebel, or a menace to the society! Even during His life on earth, Christ’s very presence was a point of remarkable debate. Some said Jesus was God, and others said He was demon possessed. Some said Jesus was a good teacher, and others called Him a liar. Some said He was brilliant, and others labeled Him insane. Jesus was applauded as a prophet, and He was dismissed as a babbling blasphemer. Some hated Him and ultimately, they put Him to death! Even today, people deem Him irrelevant or even as a threat to the society.

The follow-up question Jesus asked His disciples is even more pointed and critical than the first:

“But who do you say that I am?” Peter answered and said to Him, “You are the Christ.” (Mark 8:29).

In the passages of Bible, several people had a personal encounter with Jesus that forever changed their lives. I want to share a few of their statements about Jesus.

- Simeon declared Jesus is Salvation – ***Luke 2:30, “For my eyes have seen Your salvation”.***
- For Nathaniel, Jesus is the King of Israel – ***John 1:49, “Rabbi, You are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!”***
- Simon Peter declared Jesus as Son of the living God – ***Matthew 16:16, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.”***
- The Samaritan Woman at The Well pondered Jesus as Christ, the Messiah – ***John 4:29, “Could this be the Christ?”***

- Martha believed Jesus as the Son of God – **John 11:27 “Yes, Lord, I believe that You are the Christ, the Son of God, who is to come into the world”**
- The Roman Centurion testified Jesus as Son of God – **Mark 15:39 “Truly this man was the Son of God.”**
- For Thomas, Jesus as his Lord and his God – **John 20:28 “My Lord and my God.”**


Did anyone ask this question to you - Who is Jesus to you? Your response to this question will testify your walk with God. If one of your friend asks you this question, what will be your response? I want you to ponder this in your heart.

Do you know the story about the Five Blind Men and the Elephant? There were five blind men, blind since birth. They had never seen an elephant. Each of them was taken to an elephant and allowed to feel with his hands one part of the elephant: an ear, the tail, a tusk, the trunk, and a foot. Then they were asked to describe the elephant. Each man described what he had felt with his hands, and of course each one described something different: the foot for example was totally different to the trunk. None of them was really wrong. Each man was correct in what he described. It was just that they each had a different experience of the elephant, and could only describe that part.

Many times, this is how we try to describe Jesus. Each of us describe Jesus based on our experience with Jesus, and it is a true one, but our knowledge of Jesus is limited. We may have tasted only a part of Jesus.

What is your experience with Jesus?

- Is He just a baby Jesus at the manger in Christmas?
- Is He just a man on a cross at Easter?
- Is He a way to God, just one among many?
- Is He a good man?
- Is He a great teacher and a prophet?
- Is He a liar?
- Is He a lunatic?
- Is He your LORD?
- Is He the way, the truth and the life?
- Is He the crucified and risen Lord of your life?
- Is He the Son of God and your only hope for salvation?



For Peter, Jesus is the Son of the living God. **Matthew 16:15-17 - Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."**

How about you? Who is Jesus to you? This question is personal to you. What is the testimony of your heart today?

I say Jesus is my LORD. He is my boss. LORD means He is the ruler of my life, not just my boss, but He is the one that rules everything in my life. Nevertheless, whenever I say Jesus is my LORD, I hear this verse,

Luke 6:46 - “But why do you call Me ‘Lord, Lord,’ and not do the things which I say?”

Some things He asks us to do we will do. However, are we doing all things Jesus ask us to do? Are you able to surrender your life completely to Jesus in everything?

PROMISE MESSAGE

**“...He will not leave you nor forsake you;
do not fear nor be dismayed.”
Deuteronomy 8:31 (NKJV)**

***...He will not leave you nor forsake you;
do not fear nor be dismayed. - Deuteronomy 8:31***

Knowing that the Lord who created the heavens and the earth is with us, is a great blessing. As it is mentioned in the above verse God has promised to be with His people, He will not leave us or forsake us. In today's promise message will see all the blessings that we have as God's people, when the Lord our God is with us.

1. God leads us:

***“In the daytime also He led them with the cloud, And all the night with a light of fire”
Psalms 78:14***

When the people of Israel came of out Egypt, the Lord led them through the Wilderness. As they were going through the wilderness God was with them as pillar of fire by night to provide them with light in the darkness and as a pillar of cloud in the daytime to protect them from the heat in the desert. God knows what we need for each season, He will provide us and lead us accordingly. We are often worried about our times, perhaps you are worried about the times in your life and the uncertainties of your future. Take heart! God will take care of your needs at the right time.

In the Bible we can read about a man named Joseph. When he was still a young man, God showed him a dream about the things that were going to come to pass in his future. But it took time before these things were fulfilled, it was almost 13 years when his dreams had come true. Yet we can read that God was with Joseph at every stage of his life; He showed favor when Joseph was thrown into the pit by his brothers who wanted to kill him. God was with him when he was sold as a slave in Egypt. God was with Joseph even when he was falsely accused and thrown in the prison! Moreover the people to whom Joseph was a blessing forgot him but the Lord never left Joseph. He lifted him and brought him honor at the right time in his life. In the same way in your life too, God will bring the right blessings in His perfect

timing. Bible says in *Ecclesiastics 3:11 He has made everything beautiful in its time.* Sometime in our eyes it could look like its too late, but we need to believe that God's timings are perfect. As God fulfilled His word in Joseph's life He will fulfill in yours too. Until then He will never leave you nor forsake you.

*And the Lord went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so as to go by day and night. He did not take away the pillar of cloud by day or the pillar of fire by night from before the people.
Exodus 13:21, 22*

2. God counsels us:

Then Moses went up into the mountain, and a cloud covered the mountain. Now the glory of the Lord rested on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days. And on the seventh day He called to Moses out of the midst of the cloud. Exodus 24:15, 16

Did any people ever hear the voice of God speaking out of the midst of the fire, as you have heard, and live? Exodus 4:33



The above verses tells us how the Lord spoke to His people in the wilderness. When Moses led the people in the wilderness, God called Moses to come to Mount Sinai. When Moses climbed up Mount Sinai, a cloud covered the mountain and the Lord spoke out of the midst of the cloud to Moses and instructed him to build a tabernacle by giving all the details for it. Not only through the clouds, had God also spoke to the people of Israel out of the midst of fire. In the sight of all people, a pillar of fire came on the Mount Sinai filling the place. The Lord spoke from the midst of it to instruct His people on what to do. The Lord continues to be with us because He desires to counsel and guide us.

Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, "This is the way, walk in it," Whenever you turn to the right hand or whenever you turn to the left. Isaiah 30:21

I believe, as the Lord led the people through the pillar of cloud and fire, He desires to lead us through His word all through this month. You will hear the voice of God, His voice will bring strength. Even through all circumstances, His word will lead us in victory. He will correct us. He will make a way where there is no way. Don't be discouraged, the Lord is with you always, He will counsel and guide you.

***I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will guide you with My eye.
Psalms 32:8***

3. God fights for us:

Now it came to pass, in the morning watch that the Lord looked down upon the army of the Egyptians through the pillar of fire and cloud, and He troubled the army of the Egyptians - Exodus 14:24



When Lord delivered the people of Israel from Egypt, they stood before the Red Sea. When they knew that Pharaoh followed them from behind, they cried unto the Lord for His help. So the pillar of cloud that was ahead of them went behind them, standing between the pharaoh and the Israelites. The pillar was a pillar of fire to the people of Israel and darkness for the Egyptians. The Lord troubled the army of the Egyptians. While God led the people by parting the red sea, He overthrew their enemies while they tried to cross the sea. The same God who fought the battles for Israel is with us today. Fear not! Because the Lord is with you, He will give you victory. He will not give you into the hands of the enemy. He will fight against your enemies and give you victory. No one can stand against God.

The Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace. Exodus 14:14
