



Taste and See




TEEN'S PAGE - RANJITH KOILRAJ

"How sweet are Your words to my taste, Sweeter than honey to my mouth!" Psalms 119:103


We read in Psalms 119:103 about the sweetness of His word he describes it as sweeter than honey. Where is your delight, is that in the word of God or in the worldly things?

- Colossians 2:7 (NLT)***



***Behold, I will do a new thing, Now it shall spring forth;
Shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness
And rivers in the desert. Isaiah 43:19***

Greetings to dear sisters in Christ, I pray for God's love and protection upon each one of you throughout this month. Promise that God has given us for this month is from Isaiah 43:19 "Behold I will do a new thing... ". God desires to help us out of our past and begin a new thing in our lives! Today we will meditate on the life of Paul, the new things that God did in his life and how he responded to it.

1. Obedience

***As he journeyed, he came near Damascus, and suddenly a light shone around him from heaven. Then he fell to the ground, and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?" And he said, "Who are You, Lord?" Then the Lord said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. It is hard for you to kick against the goads."
Acts 9:3-5***


In the above verse we can see how God met Saul on his way to Damascus. At this time Paul was a man who made a havoc of the church, entering every house, and dragging off men and women, committing them to prison. He was traveling to Damascus with letters from the High priest to persecute believers in the synagogues of Damascus. Jesus intervened in his plans in a super natural way in order to do a new thing in Paul's life. Trembling and astonished, Paul said, "Lord, what do You want me to do?" Then the Lord said to him, "Arise and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do." (Acts 9:6). When Paul obeyed the voice of Jesus and God began to unfold many new things for him. Similarly, when we want to see new things in our lives, we need to obey the voice of God, then God will lead us into the new plans he has for us. 3 days after Paul went into the city, Jesus instructed a man named

Ananias to visit him and when Ananias laid hands on him and prayed, God restored Paul's eye sight and filled him with His Holy Spirit which was the beginning of Apostle Paul's great journey in Christ.

2. Be in Christ

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new 2 Corinthians 5:17

Apostle Paul not only receive Jesus into his heart but continually lived his life 'in Christ'. When the Lord met Ananias in a vision asking him to go and lay hands on Paul, Ananias answered, "Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how much harm he has done to Your saints in Jerusalem. And here he has authority from the chief priests to bind all who call on Your name." But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen vessel of Mine to bear My name before Gentiles, kings, and the children of Israel. For I will show him how many things he must suffer for My name's sake." (Acts 9:12-16). Not only Ananias but other disciples also were afraid to accept Paul but he continued to strengthened himself in Christ and preach the gospel to many people. God began to use a man who persecuted the church to build His church. When we are in Christ, old things have passed way and all things are made new. All we need to do is to keep ourselves in Christ.



3. Forget the past

but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. Philippians 3:13-14

We have been seeing that God desires to do a new thing in our lives but in order to receive the new things we should forget the past and press forward to receive that which God has for us. Looking back at his own life Paul describes how zealous he had been for the Lord and also the things he had done when he persecuted the church, he had both good and bad memories. Yet he was determined not to look back but to press toward the goal that he had in Christ. If you and I desire to arise and shine for Jesus, we should also decide not to focus on our past memories but keep our focus toward the call of God in our lives. God has a purpose and goal for our lives, let's keep our eyes on Jesus and press on to accomplish His will for our lives.

I pray that the Lord will bless you and lead you according this promise all through this month. God bless you.

PROMISE MESSAGE

THE BATTLE BELONGS TO THE LORD

And he said, “Listen, all you of Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem, and you, King Jehoshaphat! Thus says the LORD to you: ‘Do not be afraid nor dismayed because of this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God’s. – 2Chronicles 20:15

The Lord has promised in the above promise and told them that He will do their battles. Even in our lives we face many battles. In this promise message, I will share why we face these battles, how the Lord will fight for us and give us victory.

1. TO PROTECT OUR INHERITANCE:

Here they are, rewarding us by coming to throw us out of Your possession which You have given us to inherit. – 2Chronicles 20:11

The Moabites, the Ammonites and many others came against king Jehoshaphat at the same time for battle. The enemies wanted to chase them away from their inheritance which was given to him by the Lord. When Jehoshaphat knew this, immediately he called his people to pray and seek the Lord for His help. They stood before the Lord and prayed. He said, Lord we do not have strength to resist this great multitude. Then, the Holy Spirit came upon a certain man and gave His word. The Lord said to them, do not be afraid of this great multitude for the battle is not yours but it is of the Lord. Moreover, in 2Chronicles 20:17, He says that, “Stand still and see the salvation of the Lord”. This promise brought a lot of encouragement in the battlefield. According to the counsel of the Lord, Jehoshaphat sent the worshippers to be in the frontline of the battlefield. The Bible says that when they began to sing praises, the Moabites and Ammonites fought among themselves and killed each other. The Lord did not allow His people to fight. Instead He, Himself fought for them. The Bible records that on the fourth day, they assembled in the Valley of Berachah and they blessed the Lord. The battlefield turned to a field of praise.

The Lord is fighting for you also. The enemy will try to drive you away from the blessings and the possessions that were given to you by the Lord. But you seek the Lord for His favor and He will fight for you. Your battlefield will turn into a field of praise. Hence, do not be discouraged.

2. TO KEEP US ABOVE:

If he is able to fight with me and kill me, then we will be your servants. But if I prevail against him and kill him, then you shall be our servants and serve us.”
And the Philistine said, “I defy the armies of Israel this day; give me a man, that we may fight together.”- 1Samuel 17:9,10

Here we come to know that a Philistine giant called Goliath challenges the people of the Lord. He called one person to fight with him. Goliath said that if one person among you can fight and win the battle with me, then we will be your servants otherwise the Israelites must be servants to the Philistines. His intention was to bring the Israelites under the Philistines to serve them. That was the reason for him to come for the battle against the children of God. King Saul and the Israelites were frightened and fled by seeing his physical appearance, threat and weapons. Although their intentions were to enslave the Israelites, the promise of the Lord says, “ The Lord will make you the head and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not be beneath.



Even in your life, the Lord will fight against the enemy who is trying to pull you down. The Lord will give you victory over the enemy who is trying to destroy you and He will keep you on the highest positions. The Lord will make you a head and not the tail, above and not beneath. Therefore, do not be discouraged.

3. TO ACCOMPLISH OUR WORK:

*And all of them conspired together to come and attack Jerusalem and create confusion. And our adversaries said, "They will neither know nor see anything, till we come into their midst and kill them and cause the work to cease."
– Nehemiah 4:8&11*

Here we see that when Nehemiah was rebuilding the walls of Jerusalem, two men named Sanballat and Tobiah tried to stop it. They threatened and teased them. But Nehemiah and the people with him continued to build the walls without ceasing. Nehemiah 4:7 says when Sanballat, Tobiah, the Arabs, the Ammonites, and the Ashdodites heard that the walls of Jerusalem were being restored and the gaps were beginning to be closed, that they became very angry. In Nehemiah 4:11, the Bible records that they came together to cease the work. The intentions of these people were to stop the progress of the work done by Nehemiah and his people. When Nehemiah knew what they were determined to do, he looked upon the Lord and prayed. Not only that, he also allotted people to guard it day and night. Nehemiah knew what they purposed secretly. When Sanballat and Tobiah knew that Nehemiah knew their plan, they realized that God has brought their counsel to nothing and they left Nehemiah. The Lord banished the intentions of the enemies. Then Nehemiah encouraged the people who were working at the restoration of the wall by holding the spears, the shields, the bows and wore armor. Not only that, they worked with one hand and they held their weapon in the other hand [Nehemiah 4:16&17].



Even when Nehemiah gave the weapons to them, he looked at them and said, our Lord will fight for us. Nehemiah continued to work. The reason why Nehemiah continued to work was that he knew that the Lord will fight for them. The work was given to him by the Lord. So, he believed that God will help him to fulfill the work that was given to him. Therefore, he accomplished the work by holding on to his faith.

In your life also God will help you to accomplish all that He has asked you to do. In whatever work that you are involved in, it can be ministry, personal work, business, or family; the Lord will fight for you and help you to accomplish. Therefore, do not be discouraged.

Let the Lord bless you through this message. Because the Lord is going to fight for you, do not fear or be discouraged. The Lord will give you victory throughout this month. Amen.

BRAVE MIRIAM

In Exodus 2:1-10 we read, Miriam lived with her parents and older brother Aaron in the land of Egypt. Pharaoh, King of Egypt did not like Hebrew babies so he ordered them to be killed. Miriam knew her mother was going to have a baby soon. She was scared when she heard about the new laws from the Pharaoh.

Once the baby boy was born, Miriam and her family kept the baby hidden for 3 months. When they could no longer hide him, Miriam's mother kept the baby safely inside a basket and placed it along the river. Miriam stood at a distance to see what would happen.

At this time, Pharaoh's daughter went down to the river with her attendants. She saw the basket among the reeds and sent her servant to get it. When she opened it, she saw a cute baby crying inside. She felt sorry for him and decided to keep him with her. Then Miriam ran and asked Pharaoh's daughter, "Shall I go and get one of the Hebrew women to nurse the baby for you?". "Yes, go," she answered. So, she went and got the baby's mother. Pharaoh's daughter said to her, "Take this baby and nurse him for me, and I will pay you." So, the woman took the baby and nursed him. When the child grew older, she took him to Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. She named him Moses, saying, "I drew him out of the water".

Here we see Miriam stepping up during a difficult time in her family. She supported her mother and helped to save her brother. She boldly approached the princess and offered to help. Later on the same baby, Moses became the leader for the nation of Israel whom God used mightily to save His people from the hand of Pharaoh. When you boldly stand for God, He will use you also to do His will!


