

He will give us victory. Just as how He overthrew the pharaoh and his armies, He will overthrow your enemies once and for all.




King David:

“Now David was greatly distressed, for the people spoke of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and his daughters. But David strengthened himself in the Lord his God.” - 1 Samuel 30:6

Here David went through a very distressing situation. The enemies of David captured wives and children who remained in the camp while he and his men were away. Because of their distress David’s men cried out loudly and became angry at David and tried to stone him. But David even in midst of all this trouble did not fret and make a hasty to move. He kept his peace and sought the Lord. He enquired the Lord asking if he can pursue the enemy and according to God’s word he pursued, defeated the enemy and restored all that he had lost and more. In our distress too, God desires for us to keep our peace. Jesus said “...My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do, I give to you. ***“Delight yourself also in the Lord, And He shall give you the desires of your heart.”
- Psalm 37:4***

There are several promises in God’s word assuring us that it is God’s will and desire to bless us. His plans for us is for good and not to harm us. Yet why is it that our prayers go unanswered. In Matthew chapter 6, talking about prayer, Jesus said “...For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him.” So how should we pray? Do you know that there are several things mentioned in the bible that can hinder our prayers? Perhaps most people know that sin can hinder our prayers (If I regard iniquity in my heart, The Lord will not hear. Psalms 66:18). This is true but there are other reasons too. We will see few of such reasons and learn how we ought to live in a way that is pleasing to God. When we delight in God and be pleasing to Him, He will give us the desires of our hearts!

Motives:

“You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend it on your pleasures.” - James 4:3

When teaching His disciples how to pray, Jesus first said do not pray like those who pray in order to be seen by others (Matthew 6:5). God looks at our hearts and intentions even though others around us might not. When Solomon prayed for wisdom, God was pleased with him because he chose not to ask for victory over his enemies or for riches for Himself but for wise and understanding heart. God gave him more than what Solomon asked! God said along with wisdom I have also given you what you have not asked: both riches and honor. (1 Kings 3:13).

Show mercy:

***“Whoever shuts his ears to the cry of the poor Will also cry himself and not be heard.”
- Proverbs 21:13***

When we have pride in our hearts, we fail to recognize how much mercy and goodness God has shown us. As God’s children when we choose to be a blessing to others, God remembers us when we cry out to Him (Psalms 41: 1-3). Jesus said, “Blessed are the merciful for they shall obtain mercy”. This is God’s promise to us. Showing mercy also means forgiving others even though we feel they don’t deserve it; just like how God forgives us when we sin against Him. (Matthew 18:23-35) Bible says



“Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, when it is in the power of your hand to do so.” - Proverbs 3:27.

Carnal mind:

***“For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways,” says the Lord.
“For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways,
And My thoughts than your thoughts...” - Isaiah 55:8-9***

In Mark 10:37 James and John, disciples of Jesus asked Him saying “Grant us that we may sit, one on Your right hand and the other on Your left, in Your glory.” But Jesus said to them, “You do not know what you ask...” Here Jesus did not rebuke his disciples for wrong motives or their pride but answered them saying you do not know what you are asking because they didn’t understand what God was going to do. They thought Jesus was going to become a king on this earth to save the people. But God’s plan is eternal. Sometimes our prayers also focus only on the earthly blessing without considering the eternal plan God has for us. Like James and John, we might not understand it now but we need to trust God even in such times. When we believe God and walk in His ways, He will reveal His mighty plans to us

- Daniel 6: 1- 28

The Bible tells us the story of Daniel, who loved and served God even though everyone around him did not. Darius King of Babylon respected Daniel so much, he thought making him the ruler over the whole Kingdom. Luke 8:50 (NKJV)*

God wants to bless us with this promise in this month of March. Many a times we go through instances that shake our faith but God wants us to be strong in our faith and not grow weary. In this month’s message we are going to see the kind of blessing we will receive when we are strong in faith.

1. Faith Accomplishes:

*“But when Jesus heard it, He answered him, saying,
“Do not be afraid; only believe, and she will be made well.”
- Luke 8:50*

This verse is what Jesus spoke to Jairus. Jairus was a man who was concerned with his daughter’s health and so he came to Jesus and fell at His feet and begged Him to come home. When Jesus agreed and He was on his way to Jairus’ home, there was a woman who was desperate to be healed and touched the hem of His garment. This caused a delay in Jesus going to Jairus’ home. During this time, few people came from Jairus’ house and informed that his daughter was dead and not to trouble Jesus anymore.



But when Jesus heard this, He turned to Jairus and said, “Do not be afraid; only believe.” Jesus then continued on His way to Jairus’ and He raised his daughter from the dead and gave her back to them.

In your life too God has started a good work and He is able to finish that which He started. He will not stop till He finishes. Do not be discouraged, be strong in your faith!

“being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;”



2. Faith Revives:

“Jesus said to her, “Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?”

- John 11:40 (NKJV)

Jesus spoke these words to Martha. Martha’s brother Lazarus was also a friend of Jesus Christ. Lazarus became sick and so Martha and Mary (his sisters) sent a message to Jesus to let him know that His friend was sick. The scripture tells us that when Jesus heard of the sickness, He stayed two more days in the place He was (John 11:6). Later we see that Jesus knowing that Lazarus is dead tells the disciples that Lazarus is sleep and that He needs to go and wake him (John 11:11). When Jesus went to the town where Lazarus was, Martha came and told Jesus that if He had been there Lazarus would not have died. At that time Jesus looked at her and said, “..Your brother will rise again” (John 11:23) Jesus then went to the tomb that Lazarus was laid in and asked for the stone to be taken away. Martha at that time looked at Jesus and said it has already been 4 days and there is a stench (John 11:39). Jesus replied, “..“Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?” Jesus then cried out, “Lazarus, come forth!” and at that time Lazarus walked out of the grave.



You too maybe in a situation that looks dead but God can revive the dead situation and bring it back to life. He will send His word to perform miracles in your life, only believe. Do not be discouraged.

- Mark 9:23 (NKJV)


3. Faith brings Victory:


