You can visit our website to check for latest updates on upcoming meetings and events.



Father's Promises

For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." - Romans 8:15

In the beginning, God created us in His own image and His purpose for us has always been to have fellowship with Him and to do His will as sons and daughters on this earth. Fear is not God's will for us. Jesus Christ paid a price for our sins by His death on the cross so that we can come boldly to God calling Him as our Father. Bible says "For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said... "I will be a Father to you, and you shall be My sons and daughters..." (2 Corinthians 6:14-18). It is a great privilege to know God as our Father. Bible says as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name John 1:12. We can know God as our Father when we receive Jesus and believe in His name. When we pray and ask God, His Holy Spirit can reveal this truth to us and help us to call out to God as Abba Father. Let us see from the scriptures what God has promised for His children.

Promise of Everlasting Love:

"Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore, with lovingkindness I have drawn you." - Jeremiah 31:3

If there is one thing that bible doesn't have an answer to, it is why such a great and mighty God, who created the heavens and earth would love us. The above verse was spoken by the Lord to the people of

Israel. Before God delivered Israel out of Egypt, He spoke to Pharaoh saying “Israel is My son, My first-born. So, I say to you, let My son go that he may serve Me. Exodus 4:22,23. Israel was a nation chosen by God to reveal His glory but they often fell into sin and failed to walk in His precepts. In Jeremiah chapter 30 we read how the people of Israel were afflicted because of their sins. God allowed them to go through a time of pain and affliction but did not forget them forever. He assured them of His love and promised to deliver them from all their trouble. He said to them “I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore, with lovingkindness I have drawn you.” Sometimes in our lives too there might be times we feel too far from the Lord but bible says He will never leave us nor forsake. Even when we sin, He will correct us as a Father corrects a child but when we call on Him, He will come to help us.

“As a father pities his children, So the Lord pities those who fear Him” - Psalm 103:13

Promise of God’s Provision:

“Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you... If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!”
- Matthew 7:7-11

The above verse says He is a good Father who desires to give us what is good when we ask Him. Bible says, eye has not seen ear has not heard what the Lord has prepared for those who love Him (1 Corinthians 2:9). Jesus spoke many parables comparing our relationship with God to a relationship of a father and son. In the parable of prodigal son, He illustrates a relationship between a rebellious son and a father. When Jesus taught us how to pray, He begins by teaching us how we should relate to God. The first words in the Lord’s prayer tell us that God is our Father. God is a good Father who will never fail to provide for His children. The Psalmist said, I have been young, and now am old; Yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his descendants begging bread (Psalm 37:25). So do not fear but bring your needs before God and He will provide the best for you.

Promise of God’s Protection:

- Psalm 17:8

The above verse was a prayer of David. God testified about David, saying He is a man after His own heart. This means David was a man who knew the heart of God. For this month God desires to speak to us from this below verse:

“Whatever He says to you, do it.” - John 2:5

Wedding at Cana:

These words were spoken by Jesus during a wedding where Jesus and His disciples were invited. When they ran out of wine, Mary called few of the servants and instructed them to do whatever Jesus says. There were few pots of stone with water according to their custom for purification of Jews. So, Jesus asked the servants to fill those pots with water. Without asking for any explanation, the servants did as He said. Then He asked them to draw some and take it to the Master of the feast. After they drew some water and gave to the master of the feast, they realized that the water had turned into wine! Moreover, it tasted better than the wine that they had run out off! As a result of their obedience to Jesus, these servants were able to witness a great miracle. We are also called to do whatever He tells us to do and when we obey Him, we will also see miracles in our lives.

Paul:

Bible talks about a man named Saul. He was a man who persecuted those who followed Jesus. He was a constant threat to the early church. One day while he was on his way to Damascus to persecute the believers of Christ, suddenly a light shone around him from heaven and he fell to the ground (Acts 9:3). He trembled and said, “Lord, what do You want me to do?” Then the Lord said to him, “Arise and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do.” Because of the brightness of the light, Saul could no



longer see so he was led by other into the city and he stayed there for three days. The Lord sent a man named Ananias to pray for Paul. Paul was baptized by the Holy Spirit and started to preach Christ in synagogues. Many people who heard his testimony were touched and believed in Jesus. Paul also traveled to several places to establish churches and strengthen believers in Christ. As a result of Paul's obedience to God's voice, he was used by God to be a great blessing to others. In our lives too when we choose to obey God, we can become a blessing to others. God desires to make you also instrument of blessing for His kingdom.

Peter:

Peter was on a housetop where he went to pray and he fell into a trance and saw heaven open like a blanket and in it were all kinds of four-footed animals of the earth, wild beasts, creeping things, and birds of the air. And a voice came to him, "Rise, Peter; kill and eat. But Peter responded saying "Not so, Lord! For I have never eaten anything common or unclean." but he heard the voice again and again and then blanket was taken back into heaven. At that time there were few men sent by a man named Cornelius, a gentile who was divinely instructed to invite Peter to his house. It was against the custom of Jews to enter into a gentile's home but prompted by the Holy Spirit, Peter accompanied them to Cornelius's house and preached the gospel to all those who had gathered there to hear him. While Peter was still speaking to them, Holy Spirit fell on them. Because of Peter's obedience to the voice of God, He witnessed a mighty work of God. We should also be sensitive to the voice of God and obey His word. When we do so we will also be able to witness the mighty works of God in our lives and in others.

Today we ought to search our hearts. As Christians we go to church, we pray, read bible, give tithes and offerings to God but are we obeying the voice of God? If not let us make a decision today to listen and obey His voice. Let the Lord bless you and guide you throughout this month. Amen.

Wait
ON THE
LORD

***“...Then you will know that I am the Lord,
For they shall not be ashamed who wait for Me.” - Isaiah 49:23***

Here we see a promise of God, He says “I’m the Lord, those who wait for me will not be ashamed”. We will not be ashamed because in the life of God’s people all things work together for good in the end. We will meditate on the blessings that come from waiting on the Lord.

Rise Up:

***“But those who wait on the Lord
Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles,
They shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.” - Isaiah 40:31***

Those who wait on the Lord will not be let down instead they will rise up like eagles. Before Jesus was taken up to heaven, He told His disciples to wait for the promise of the Father, the power of the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:5). So, the disciples went to the upper room and waited with one accord by spending time in prayer and supplication. (Acts 1:14). Then suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. And there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them (Acts 2:2-4) When God’s promise was fulfilled, they received a supernatural experience. Not only that they also received a divine boldness. Then Peter rose up from among them and spoke to the people saying, what happened was a fulfilment of God’s prophecy spoken by prophet Joel: ***“And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour***

out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your young men shall see visions, your old men shall dream dreams. And on My menservants and on My maidservants, I will pour out My Spirit in those days;”- Acts 2:17,18. After being endowed with the power of God, they no longer locked themselves inside a room out of fear. They openly shared the gospel to many who received and performed signs and wonders in the name of Jesus Christ. Even in midst of severe threats and persecutions they chose to please God and not men. They rose up with wings like eagles so God was able to perform mighty miracles through them to bring many people to the knowledge of Christ and receive eternal life. Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. Acts 2:43.

In the same way when we wait on the Lord, we will also rise up like eagles. Do not look at your current situation, you will receive a divine strength from God to do mighty things for His kingdom.

Restore:

So, David inquired of the Lord, saying, “Shall I pursue this troop? Shall I overtake them?” And He answered him, “Pursue, for you shall surely overtake them and without fail recover all.” - 1 Samuel 30:8

Bible says, David was a man who waited on the Lord. In this above verse we can see how David inquired of the Lord. He sought the Lord and asked “Shall I pursue?” “Shall I overtake?” and the Lord answered him and said “Pursue, for you shall surely overtake them and without fail recover all.” He inquired the Lord when his wives, children and all that he had were captured by his enemies. Bible says he and the men lifted their voices and wept until they had no more power to weep. (1 Samuel 30:4). David went through great distress as his men spoke of stoning him because of their grief. (1 Samuel 30:6). During this time David waited on the Lord and inquired if he can pursue his enemies. He did not fret or rush out in his anger but chose to wait and seek the Lord. Upon receiving the word from God, He gained strength to pursue his enemies. When he was on the way to pursue his enemies, some of the men with him became weary and could not accompany but he continued his pursuit and God helped David through an Egyptian man to locate the place where his wives and children were taken. They fought all night and defeated their enemy (1 Samuel 30:17). According to the promise of God, he recovered all. And nothing of theirs was lacking, either small or great, sons or daughters, spoil or anything which they had taken from them; David recovered all. (1 Samuel 30:19)



“For this child I prayed, and the Lord has granted me my petition which I asked of Him.” - 1 Samuel 1:27

These were words spoken by a woman named Hannah who was waiting for a child. She did not have a child because the Lord had closed her womb (1 Samuel 1:6) She waited for several years and was often provoked by her rival because she did not have a child. She poured out her heart to the Lord and made a vow to Him saying “O Lord of hosts, if You will indeed look on the affliction of Your maidservant and remember me, and not forget Your maidservant, but will give Your maidservant a male child, then I will give him to the Lord all the days of his life...” 1 Samuel 1:11 After she has prayed, she was blessed by the Lord’s servant Eli (1 Samuel 1:17). Bible says she was no longer sad and later that year, the Lord remembered Hannah. This woman who waited on the Lord received a change and her blessing from the Lord. She received peace, joy and an answer to her prayer. Above all these, she was remembered by the Lord. The Lord blessed her with a son according to her prayer and she named him Samuel and she gave him to the Lord just as she had vowed to God. When you wait on the Lord, you will also receive from the Lord and see great changes in your life.



In all the three incidents mentioned above, these people of God prayed and sought the Lord. All the disciples were praying to the Lord, David sought the Lord and inquired of Him, Hannah poured her heart to the Lord. All these people waited on the Lord by making prayer and supplication so they were not ashamed. God proved to them that He was with them and fulfilled His promises. If you are waiting for something in your life, God desires for you to spend time in His presence praying to Him. Pour your heart to Him and pray, He will not allow you to be ashamed. FAITHFULNESS - Doing what you say you will do.




GENTLENESS - Being thoughtful or considerate of other people.






