2. Sacrifice of thanksgiving:


***“I will offer to You the sacrifice of thanksgiving,

Greetings to all my dear sisters in Christ. We thank God for all your prayers for this ministry and for us. God has graciously brought us into another new month in our lives. We believe that God will speak to you and encourage through His word as you read this message.

This month we will mediate on God's word to see how God answered the prayers of His people and what we can learn from these scriptures.

Wait on Him:

But the angel said to him, "Do not be afraid, Zacharias, for your prayer is heard; and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John." - Luke 1:13

The above verse was spoken by an angel who was sent from God to Zacharias when he was ministering before God in the most holy place. Zacharias and Elizabeth were old couple who lived blamelessly before God but they did not have a child. There are times in our lives when prayers were answered immediately. As God's people some of you might have seen miracles that God has done in your own lives and in others. But there are times when God seems silent. A time we become restless because we are not able to reason with our minds how a God who loves and cares for us, not answer us when we cry to Him desperately. It's a time when God stretches our faith in Him. Zacharias and Elizabeth may have been praying for many years. Being a priest in the temple of God, Zacharias would have to live a consecrated life and keep praying to God even though his prayers were not answered. There were many servants of God in the bible who waited on the Lord. When the Lord called Moses to the mountain, Moses had to

wait for 6 days before the Lord spoke to him. Have you wondered why? Perhaps God uses this time to work in us! There many people in the bible who had to wait for God's answer and each time we see that when their prayers were answered it brought glory to His name. When Zacharias and Elizabeth's prayer was answered, many people marveled and glorified God. His answer brought great joy to them and many others (Luke 1:14 & vs 58). God can do the same in your lives too. Some of you may be praying and seeking God for something in your life or for salvation of your loved ones. I encourage you to trust in God and do not lose hope. We serve a prayer answering God. He is able to answer your prayers as you continue to seek Him and wait for Him.

Faith in Him:

“And a certain centurion's servant, who was dear to him, was sick and ready to die. So when he heard about Jesus, he sent elders of the Jews to Him, pleading with Him to come and heal his servant.” - Luke 7:2-3

In this above verse we see how a centurion received answer for his prayer. He sought Jesus to heal one of his servants. This man had a greater revelation of Jesus than most of the Israelites of his time. When the centurion heard that Jesus was in his vicinity, he sent some of the elders to meet him because he considered himself unworthy to meet Jesus in person. He believed that Jesus had authority over all things. He believed that His word has power to heal the sick. His faith made Jesus marvel. His prayer was answered instantly. Bible says “If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes.” Mark 9:23. During the time when Jesus was in this world, He performed many miracles and healings. To many people who came to Him for healing, Jesus asked only one question, “do you believe?”. Although there were many who were healed there were some places where Jesus' travelled and could not do many miracles because of their unbelief (Matthew 13:58). Do you believe that God can answer your prayer? When we spend time in God's presence and meditate on His word, God will give us faith. Our faith will change our perspective and our prayer life. By faith in God's word, we can receive answer to our prayers.

PROMISE MESSAGE



***“But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.”
- 1 Corinthians 15:57 (NKJV)***

The Lord our God wants to give us the victory. Paul writes this verse which gives thanks to the Father for giving us the victory through Jesus Christ. Because Jesus has won the victory over all things, God our Father wants to give us the same victory. In this message we will see how God will give us victory and in what He will give us victory.

1. Victory over temptations:

***“For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted,
He is able to aid those who are tempted.” - Hebrews 2:18 (NKJV)***

We read in the scriptures, that Jesus Christ was tempted by the devil. Another name for the devil mentioned in the scriptures is ‘tempter’ (Matthew 4:3). Jesus was in the wilderness for forty days without eating and drinking and it was at this time the devil came and tempted Him. The way he tempted Jesus was by using the very situation He was in, against Him. The devil knew that Jesus was hungry and tells Him, “...command that these stones become bread...” (Luke 4:3). Next, the devil tempted Jesus using authority, he took Him to the top of the mountain and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and then told Jesus, “...if You will worship before me, all will be Yours” (Luke 4:5-7). Lastly, He took Jesus and set Him on a pinnacle of the temple and said, “...throw Yourself down from here. For it is written: ‘He shall give His angels charge over you,...’” (Luke 4:9). He tempted Jesus in 3 ways – by using the

current situation, offering authority & glory in exchange of His worship and using the word of God. The purpose of this temptation is to remove Jesus from the will of God. He did not succumb to any temptation but overcame them all by the word of God. He countered the first temptation by saying “It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone, [c]but by every word of God.’ ” (Matthew 4:4). Next, Jesus said. “Get behind Me, Satan! For it is written, ‘You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve.’ ” (Matthew 4:8). Lastly, He said, ““It has been said, ‘You shall not tempt the LORD your God.’ ” . This is how Jesus overcame the temptations and got the victory.

In your life many a times the devil will bring temptation. The enemy may use the situation you are going through against you to move you away from the will of God. The devil may tempt you using authority and power to move you from the will of God. But it is the will of God for you to overcome all the temptations and get the victory by using the word of God. Just like He overcame temptation, He is looking at you and telling you that you too can do the same. The scripture tells us that because He got the victory, we can boldly come to the throne of Graces. He knows our weaknesses; He will strengthen us in our weakness and give us the victory over our temptations. God is faithful to help you therefore go boldly into the presence of God and ask for help and mercy.

***“For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.”
- Hebrews 4:15-16 (NKJV)***

2. Victory over tribulations:

“In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.” - John 16:33 (NKJV)

In this world, when Jesus Christ our Savior lived us a son of man, He faced many trials and tribulations. As followers Jesus we will also face tribulations but He has asked us to be strong because He has overcome the world. Many a times we look at the trials and are overwhelmed with grief, fear and unbelief. But the God who overcame all tribulations wants to give us the victory. It is not the will of God for us to fail when we face tribulations. The God who strengthened the disciples wants to strengthen you today and give you the victory over your tribulations.

One day Jesus asked the disciples to get into a boat and go to the other side (Matthew 14:22). The scripture tells us that the disciples obeyed Jesus and got into the boat, but when they reached the middle of the sea, the wind was contrary and their boat was tossed by the ways. At that time, in the fourth watch, Jesus went to the disciples by walking on the sea (Matthew 14:25). The disciples feared thinking He was a ghost and immediate Jesus spoke saying, “...Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid.” Jesus walked on the water to help His disciples. Not only did he speak and comfort them, He also calmed the wind. So, Jesus got into their boat and the wind ceased. For a while disciples went through a trial but Jesus came to their rescue. Likewise many servants of God in the bible went through several tribulations but the Lord gave them victory.

God wants to give us victory in our tribulations. When tribulations come our way, we should keep our

eyes on Jesus and not focus on the size of our problems. Through our faith we will get victory over our tribulations.

“But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you.”
- 1 Peter 5:10 NKJV

3. Victory over the works of the enemy:

“..... For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.”
- 1 John 3:8 (NKJV)

God wants to give us victory over all the works of the enemy. When the works of the enemy comes into our life, it will derail our life and destroy it. The scripture says that the enemy comes to steal, kill and destroy (John 10:10). He comes to steal our joy, our blessing, and, our peace. Jesus wants to give us the victory over all the works of the enemy. Jesus not only won the victory over the enemy's works but He also set free all who were oppressed by the devil.

“how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.” - Acts 10:38 (NKJV)

When Jesus was in the country of the Gadarenes, He met a certain man who had demons for a long time. The scripture tells us that this man wore no clothes, and lived in the tombs. Jesus commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man, because the spirit often seized him, and drove him into the wilderness and did not allow him to lead a normal life. Jesus wanted to set him free and give him the victory. The demons begged Jesus to permit them to enter the pigs and when He permitted them, they left the man. the man from whom the demons had departed, now sat at the feet of Jesus, he was clothed and in his right mind. Here we see how Jesus destroyed the works of the enemy in the man's life and gave him the victory. Once he got the victory, he became a disciple of Jesus, went his way and proclaimed throughout the whole city what great things Jesus had done for him (Luke 8:39).

God wants to destroy the works of the enemy in your life too and wants to give you victory. The man who was demon possessed was forsaken by all yet Jesus loved him and went there just for him to set him free from bondages of the enemy. Therefore, do not be discouraged. He is a God who loves you.

“Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.”
- Romans 8:37 (NKJV)

Let God alone bless you this month and give you the victory. Let us praise God who gives us the victory. Have a blessed Thanksgiving!




