

This month God wants to remind us His promise, that He is our provider. As God's children when we honor Him with what He has blessed us with, He is faithful to meet all our needs according His riches in glory (Philippians 4:19). From the scriptures we will see two people who trusted God and saw His goodness in their lives.

A Poor Widow:

“Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom...” - Luke 6:38

During the days of Elijah, the children of Israel faced a severe drought. The Lord spoke to Elijah saying “Arise, go to Zarephath... See, I have commanded a widow there to provide for you.” 1 Kings 17:8. When Elijah went to Zarephath he did not find a widow who was rich and ready to serve him food. Rather he meets a widow who was going to prepare a meal with a handful of flour that was left for herself and her son. The famine was so severe that she told Elijah they were going to have their last meal. When Elijah heard this, he asked her to prepare a small cake for him first and said thus says the Lord God of Israel: “The bin of flour shall not be used up, nor shall the jar of oil run dry, until the day the


Lord sends rain on the earth.” The woman did according to his word and saw a great miracle. The flour and the oil did not run dry until the famine was over. The Lord had sent Elijah to the widow to provide for her. There was only one thing that she had to do to see God’s provision in her life, she had to give a portion of what she had in obedience to God’s word. Bible says our giving comes before God as a sweet aroma (Philippians 4:18). The Lord watches how we honor Him with our possessions, how we tithe, how we give to others; to the people in need. According to the measure we give, it will be measure back to us (Luke 6:38). When we give according to His word, the supply in our home will never run dry. Just as He saved this poor widow during a famine, He will remember us and provide for us at all times. Are you willing to trust Him?

A Centurion:

In the book of Acts we read about a man named Cornelius who feared the Lord, always prayed to God and gave generously to people. Cornelius was not an Israelite and it was custom of the Jews not enter a gentile’s home or eat with them. The gospel was preached only among the Jews. But the Lord sent an angel to Cornelius, who said “Cornelius!... your prayers and your alms have come up for a memorial before God.” Acts 10:4. the angel of the Lord guided him to invite Peter to their home who will share the good news of the gospel. Not only that, the Lord also spoke to Peter in a vision convincing him to go and minister to Cornelius and all who were gathered with him. According God’s leading, Peter went and shared the gospel to all who were gathered and Lord filled everyone with His Holy Spirit. Unlike the poor widow, Cornelius was not in need of an earthly miracle. His giving brought eternal blessing to him and his entire family. Through him God showed His love for the gentiles so from that time, God’s salvation was not only preached to the Jews but to everyone. In the same way when we fear God, walk in His ways and give generously to the poor, He is faithful to meet all our needs. He is able to provide more than what we can ask or imagine.

***“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for,
the evidence of things not seen”.***
- Hebrews 11:1 (NKJV)

Most of the times although we are strong in our faith, there may come some situations when we are unable to stand strong in our faith. This verse tells us that faith is the substance of things hoped for and evidence of things not seen. The scripture tells us that those who believe without seeing are more blessed (John 20:29). Thomas did not believe that Jesus was risen, he said, “Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe”. After Jesus was risen, He showed himself to His disciples but at that time Thomas was not present and therefore Thomas said that He will believe only after he sees for himself. After Thomas said this, Jesus once again showed himself to his disciples when Thomas was present and Jesus said to Thomas, “Reach your finger here, and look at My hands; and reach your hand here, and put it into My side. Do not be unbelieving, but believing.” Immediately Thomas believed and said, “My Lord and my God!”. It is at this time that Jesus said, “...Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.” Therefore, even we do not see, we need to steadily believe in Him so we can be blessed.

The scripture tells us that it is impossible to please God without faith. So, in this message, we are going to see some situations where we need to stand strong in our faith.



Having Faith in Him at all times:

Sometimes we may receive answers for our prayers immediately, scripture says, "...whatever you ask in My name, that I will do..." (John 14:13) but sometimes we do not receive answers immediately. Whether we receive answers immediately, or it may be delayed, or sometimes we may not receive an expected answer still we are called to have faith in Him.

The woman with the issue of blood, struggled with her sickness for twelve years, she spent all her wealth to get treatments but she was not healed. But one day she heard of Jesus, and although she has endured twelve years of sickness, as soon as she heard about Jesus, she decided that she would at least touch His garment to be healed (Mark 5:27). Scripture tells us that she acted on her faith and she went and touched Jesus' garment and as soon as she did, power from Jesus entered her body and she was healed. She made her decision, followed Jesus, touched His garment and immediately was healed. Then Jesus looks at her and tells her, "...your faith has made you well. Go in peace..." Just see her faith, she acted on it, and immediately was healed.



In Matthew 15:22-28, we read about a woman from Canaan who came to Jesus and cried out saying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon-possessed." But Jesus did not answer and went about doing other things but the woman persisted. Jesus then told her, "It is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the little dogs." The words may have caused her hurt but she stood on her faith and said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters' table." Jesus then looks at her and said, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire." Immediately her daughter was healed.

For the woman with the issue of blood, she got an answer immediately when she met Jesus, but the Canaanite woman's answer was delayed but this Canaanite woman persisted, did not give up, kept calling out to Jesus and received her answer. Jesus also appreciated her faith.

Many a times we may not receive an answer or get an answer that is opposite of what we prayed for, let us consider the prayer of Jesus in Gethsemane. Jesus was sorrowful and prayed, saying, "...O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will." Jesus prayed this prayer because He was soon going to the cross to carry the sins of the world and at that time He will lose the relationship with the Father and not wanting that Jesus prayed in this manner. Jesus prayed this way but ended saying let your will be done knowing fully well that His Heavenly Father will do that which is right and also Jesus wanted to fulfill the Father's will.

God is expecting this kind of faith from us, we should have faith when we receive an answer, get a delayed answer or sometime not get an expected answer.

The scriptures tell us that without faith it is impossible to please God (Hebrews 11:6). It is our faith and belief in God that will give us the victory in this world (1 John 5:4). Faith is the foundation of our relationship with the Living God because we walk by faith and not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7). Many of us have not seen Christ but we believe that He is the Living God who is with us. This month’s promise verse tells us that when we believe in God all things are possible. In this message, we are going to see the blessing that we receive when we believe in God.

1. God’s Deliverance:

*“Then they brought him to Him. And when he saw Him,
immediately the spirit convulsed him, and he fell on the ground and wallowed, foaming
at the mouth.” - Mark 9:20 (NKJV)*

Here we see a father who brings his son to Jesus because he wants Jesus to deliver his son. At that time, because Jesus was not present, the father looks to Jesus’ disciples and requests them to deliver his son. The father was desperate because when the spirit seizes his son, it throws him down; he foams at the

mouth, gnashes his teeth, and becomes rigid. This spirit was making the son's life very difficult because many times it cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him but the disciples were not able to help them. When Jesus arrived, the father tells Jesus what happened, that His disciples were not able to cast the spirit out (Mark 9:17-18). After listening to the father, Jesus tells him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes". The father immediately cried out, "Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!" (Mark 9:24). As soon as Jesus heard this, He looked at the son and commanded the spirit in him to come out and not enter him any more (Mark 9:25). The spirit cried out, tormented him greatly and then departed. At this time the boy was laying down like a dead man and Jesus reached out and lifted him and immediately he arose. Just like this the deliverance of God Almighty came to this son. The father had belief and also asked Jesus to help his unbelief. It was because of his belief that he brought the son to Jesus but maybe there was something that was hindering or obstructing his belief and that is probably why he asks Jesus to help his unbelief. Jesus honors his request and delivers his son. Many a times in our lives too although we have faith, in certain situations we may experience unbelief. At such times we should pray like this father, Lord we believe but help my unbelief, at that time just like Jesus did for this father, He will help our unbelief and meet our need. Just like deliverance came to this son, God wants to bring a deliverance in our life too. Jesus is looking at you and saying the same thing He said to this father, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes." (Mark 9:23)

Are you believing God? How is your faith? God wants to strengthen your faith. For all those who believe there is a deliverance coming from the Lord.

2. God's Power:

***"Now a woman, having a flow of blood for twelve years, who had spent all her livelihood on physicians and could not be healed by any, came from behind and touched the border of His garment. And immediately her flow of blood stopped."
- Luke 8:43-44 (NKJV)***

This verse talks about a woman who suffered 12 years of sickness and because of this she spent all her wealth to get treatment from doctors but she was not healed. At that time, this woman heard about Jesus and she said to herself, "If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well." (Mark 5:28), she had made up her mind and pushed through the crowd. The scripture tells us that she came from behind and touched only the border of Jesus' garment (Luke 8:44). At that time Jesus looked at the disciples and questioned them saying, "Who touched Me?" and the disciples answered, "..the multitudes throng and press You, and You say, 'Who touched Me?' ". Although the women touched the border of Jesus' garment without anyone's knowledge, Jesus perceived power leaving Him and knew that there was one who touched Him. At that time the woman realizing she was healed in her body, and knowing she was found came trembling forward and told Jesus everything - how she was healed by touching just His garment. Jesus tells her, "Daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has made you well. Go in peace." (Luke 8:48).

This woman who had seen many disappointments, when she heard about Jesus told herself that she will be healed if only she touched Jesus' garment. It was not only her belief, but also the steps she took to put her faith into action, this is what caused power to go out from Jesus and heal her. When we believe, we too can experience the power of God. When His power comes it will bring healing within, it will bring

about a change within us, it will remove the pain and turn our disappointments around.

3. God's Protection:

“Now the king was exceedingly glad for him, and commanded that they should take Daniel up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no injury whatever was found on him, because he believed in his God.” - Daniel 6:23 (NKJV).

Here we read about Daniel who was a man of God. Daniel was a man who was sent to the lion's den because he took a stand for God. In those days, many people in the king's palace did not like Daniel because he was favored by the king and so they sought to find some fault with him. But because they could find no fault, they decided the only way to get Daniel is to find a charge against him concerning the law of his God (Daniel 6:5). Therefore, the governors and satraps went to the king to make a firm decree, that whoever petitions any god or man for thirty days, except the king, shall be cast into the den of lions. They even convinced the king to sign the writing, so that it cannot be changed. Scripture tells us, that Daniel knowing that the decree was signed, went in his upper room, with his windows open, knelt down, and prayed and gave thanks to God, like he always did three times a day. Daniel took a stand for the Lord no matter how hard the situation. No decree could stop Daniel from praying to His God. God expects this from us also, many a times we go through sorrow or difficult times but nothing should come in between us and God. The satraps found Daniel praying and informed the king, the king realizing what the men had done, worked to deliver Daniel from the lion's den but was not successful. Daniel was cast into the den of lions. But the king spoke to Daniel and told him, “Your God, whom you serve continually, He will deliver you.” Daniel received these words of encouragement as he was sent into the den. The king did not sleep and arose early in the morning to check on Daniel, he went to the den cried out, “Daniel, servant of the living God, has your God, ...been able to deliver you from the lions?” Daniel replied, “O king, live forever! My God sent His angel and shut the lions' mouths, ...”

Many a times, we go through lion's den experience like Daniel, but when you believe in God, He will shut the mouth of the lions and bring you out.

***“No weapon formed against you shall prosper,
And every tongue which rises against you in judgment
You shall condemn.
This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD,
And their righteousness is from Me,”
Says the LORD. - Isaiah 54:17(NKJV).***

When you believe in the Lord, He will send help from above, no lion will harm you and no weapon formed against you shall prosper.

***“The LORD shall preserve you from all evil;
He shall preserve your soul”. - Psalm 121:7 (NKJV)***

In this month, God will send His deliverance, His power and His protection as you believe and draw closer to Him. Have a blessed month.

DANIEL - CHAPTERS 1, 6 & 10




