

TRUE Light



Light is essential for all of us in this earth. When the earth was without void and form, light was first thing that the LORD spoke into existence (Genesis 1:3). The LORD was mindful to create a light for day and for night (Genesis 1:16). Although this light from the sun and moon are important for our day to day lives, bible also speaks about another light, the life of Jesus – a light for our soul (John 1:4)

The LORD created man in HIS own image, breathed into his nostrils and man become a living soul (Gen 2:7). The LORD is light and in HIM there is no darkness (1 John 1:5). He was the light in man that enabled Adam to have fellowship with Him. But as soon as Adam sinned against the Lord by disobeying His word, he became fearful of God and tried to hide from Him. But Jesus came as a true light to restore man's fellowship with God.

When you believe in Jesus and commit your life to Him, He gives His Holy Spirit to dwell in you. His Spirit becomes the light in you and helps you to have fellowship with Him (1 Corinthians 2:10). But as you wonder away from God's word and allow sin in your hearts the light in you becomes dark so that you no longer have His light (Gal 5:19-21, Matthew 6:21, 22). When this happens, you may feel lonely and hopeless. You may feel like you lost the light of holiness, peace and joy and you are no longer worthy to enter Heaven and be in God's presence. But take heart, the GOD who is invisible (Col 1:15) came in the name of Jesus Christ as the true light of this world. He came to save those who are lost, to bring light into your darkness!

There was a woman who lived in the days of LORD Jesus Christ. She was called a sinner in that City (Luke 7:37). She came to know Jesus Christ who said, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life." (John 8:12) had arrived in her city and was at a Pharisees' house. Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. During this month I urge you to stir your hearts in the Lord and seek Him more. As we all know the day of the Lord's return is near and we have to be prepared and share His gospel to as many people as possible so that they can be saved as well.

"...Prepare to meet your God, O Israel!" - Amos 4:12

Bible says we have to be prepared to meet our Lord on the day of His coming. It is a great privilege for us to be able to meet Him. In our lives we have to meet with Him each day. The time we spend in His presence brings a change in our hearts and lives. In this message we will understand why we must meet the Lord and how to prepare ourselves to meet Him.

To Know Him:

"So be ready in the morning, and come up in the morning to Mount Sinai, and present yourself to Me there on the top of the mountain." - Exodus 34:2

Here we can see the Lord instructed Moses to be ready in the morning and to come up on a mountain to meet Him. He also spoke to Moses and said no one shall come up with him (Exodus 34:3). In the same way the Lord desires for us to come to Him alone. He wants us to come to Him with all our hearts without being distracted with other things. When Moses did according to the command of the Lord, He descended in a cloud and stood with him (Exodus 34:5). Then the Lord revealed Himself to him. And the Lord passed before him and proclaimed, "The Lord, the Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the

children and the children's children to the third and the fourth generation.” (Exodus 34:6-7). There were several times the Lord revealed Himself to Moses in various ways yet He gave him a new revelation this time. In the same way even though we all have known God at different times in our lives, He desires to reveal Himself in a new way. So, knowing the Lord is important in our daily walk with Him. The Lord not only revealed Himself to Moses but He spoke to Him as a man speaks a friend. When we meet with the Lord, He will give the grace to seek Him and speak to Him as Moses spoke to Him. The Lord not only spoke to Moses but made a covenant with him and the people of Israel saying He will do marvels such as have not been done in all the earth! (Exodus 34:10). and be prepared for His coming. To illustrate this, the Lord spoke a parable of ten virgins who were waiting for their bridegroom. Out of the ten, five wise virgins took lamp and some oil with them while the five foolish ones took their lamps and took no oil with them. At midnight a cry was heard: ‘Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out to meet Him!’ Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps. And the foolish said to the wise “give us some oil” but wise said to them “no lest there is not enough for us”. When the foolish virgins went to buy, the bridegroom came and those who were ready went with Him. (Matthew 25:13). The foolish virgin had the lamp but they missed His coming because they lacked oil. The Lord desires for us to be prepared for Him in every way, we must be found with the lamp and enough oil on the that day. He promised to prepare a place for us and come to take us into our eternal home, are you ready for Him?

PROMISE
-KEEPING-
GOD

“...I will not leave you until I have done what I have spoken to you.” - Genesis 28:15

This month God wants to remind us that He is a promise keeping God. Let's meditate from the scriptures to know how faithful He is and as children of God how we can inherit His promises.

1. He is Faithful:

God spoke these words to Jacob when he had left his home and was on his way to meet his uncle Laban. Jacob was alone and stayed in certain place for the night, when God visited him in a dream. The LORD revealed Himself to Jacob as the LORD God of Abraham and Isaac and promised to bless him and his descendants to inherit the land where he lay. God promised him saying “Behold, I am with you and will keep you wherever you go, and will bring you back to this land; for I will not leave you until I have done what I have spoken to you.” Genesis 28:13. After this Jacob spent twenty years with Laban and worked for him. Jacob was several times deceived by Laban who kept changing his wages but because the LORD was with him Jacob was blessed (Genesis 38:42). He was married to Laban's daughters and had sons and daughters. All the work of his hands were blessed so much so that Laban and his sons began to envy him (Genesis 31:1,2). Now the Angel of God spoke to Jacob saying “...I have seen all that Laban is doing to you. I am the God of Bethel, where you anointed the pillar and where you made a vow to Me. Now arise, get out of this land, and return to the land of your family.” According to the promise of God at the right time, the LORD brought him back to the place He had promised. In our lives too it may seem like a long journey and God has forgotten about His word. Do not give up, the LORD is with you and He sees you where you are. The promises that He spoke to you are true and He will bring it to pass. Not only that,

Jacob feared Esau, his brother who was angry with him. But when Jacob went back to the promised land obeying the word of LORD, God blessed him with peace with his brother. When we obey and follow the LORD, He will make even our enemies to be in peace with us (Proverbs 16:7)

“Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.” - Hebrews 10: 23

2. He is Able:

“...what He had promised He was also able to perform.” - Romans 4:21



Apostle Paul wrote these above words in his letter to the believers in Roman describing about Abraham's faith. He says "...And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb. He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform. And therefore "it was accounted to him for righteousness." Romans 4:19-22. Bible says it is impossible to please God without faith (Hebrews 11:6). God requires of us trust in Him, His ability and not ours. God blessed Abraham with a promise when he left his people and followed Him. But for many years nothing happened, we can read that there were several times Abraham was discouraged but God kept reminding him of His promise (Genesis 15:24). Abraham had to take his eyes off his own inability and trust on the One Who promised. When Abraham was about hundred years old and Sarah was past the age of bearing child, God visited them. He promised them again saying "I will certainly return to you according to the time of life, and behold, Sarah your wife shall have a son." Genesis 18:10. According to His word at the appointed time He visited Sarah and she bore Isaac, God's promised child (Genesis 21:1-3) Just as God blessed Sarah and Abraham, He is able to bless us too in midst of our inability. There is nothing impossible for God, believe in Him and He will do mighty things for you.

3. How to Inherit the Promise of God?

“...or you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise... ” - Hebrews 10:36

Now that we know that God is faithful to fulfil His promise and there is nothing too great for Him, what must we do to inherit His promise? Based on the scriptures here is how we can inherit His word for us: As the above verse says, one of the important things we need is patience. As we read in the passages about Jacob and Abraham, God was with them and made them increase but to fulfil His promise He had an appointed time. We need to wait patiently for God. But waiting is not easy. In order to wait on Him we need faith. Faith is another important aspect to inherit God's promise. We need to endure without unbelief or complaining against the LORD. Bible says, Abraham's faith was counted for him as righteousness! (Romans 4:22)

“Now the just shall live by faith; But if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him.” - Hebrews 10:38

One more thing we need to do is, claim the promise of God. In Joshua 14:9-12 we can see how Caleb claimed His promise. After spending forty years in the wilderness, Caleb was still strong in his faith that he said “give me this mountain of which the LORD spoke in that day” (Joshua 14:12) He did not forget what God has spoken when they were in the wilderness, forty years ago. In the same way sometimes, we need to believe and claim what God has spoken to us. The LORD who blessed Jacob, Abraham and Caleb to inherit their promises is faithful to help us. So, take heart, don't lose your hope, God is able to perform His word to you.



“For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.” - 2 Corinthians 1:20


