With the excitement of the New Year wearing off, many of us are now fully immersed in our school work, after school activities and many other day to day activities. The New Year may also present challenges we have not encountered before such as studies, friendships, etc. There are times where we step up confidently by the grace of God and there are other times where the task may seem unassailable. But the very same God who gave us strength to overcome the easier tasks will help us in these challenging opportunities as well. I am reminded of Nehemiah 8:10 which says that the joy of the Lord is our strength. He is our almighty God and he will equip us with the strength, wisdom and other abilities to meet the challenges that come our way.

The first example I can think of is Elijah who ran to the wilderness after being threatened by Jezebel. He was discouraged, depressed and lacked the strength to carry on being a prophet. Elijah was focused on Jezebel's threats and it sapped him off his strength. He had a great victory over Jezebel and Ahab's prophets and received victory by the hand of God. But when he heard these threats, he felt discouraged and weak and ran as far as he could. But God renewed his strength. 1 Kings 19:7-8 says "And the angel of the Lord came back the second time, and touched him, and said, 'Arise and eat, because the journey is too great for you. So, he arose, and ate and drank; and he went in the strength of that food forty days and forty nights as far as Horeb, the mountain of God.'"





DAVID STRENGTHENED HIMSELF IN THE LORD

I am also reminded of David's story from our promise verse which says "for you shall surely overtake them and without fail recover all." (1 Sam 30:8). David faced a challenge and he was discouraged but 1 Samuel 30:6 says that David strengthened himself in the Lord. Quite often we turn to our friends, social media, video games, etc in order to relieve ourselves of the stress and to rejuvenate ourselves. But from David's example we can learn that we can turn to God for strength during time of need.

Sometimes temptation and sin may even lure us when we are weak and in need of strength against challenging situations. I am reminded of James 4:7 which says "Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you." When we are weak, vulnerable and need of encouragement, we often feel alone and lonely. We are more likely to turn to sinful ways as way to recuperate. But James commands us to turn to God during times of temptation so that we can resist the attack of the enemy. Similarly, when we are facing life situations that are draining us of our strength where we are in dire need of strength, energy and motivation, we can turn to God through prayer and reading the Bible.

And finally, we can ask God to fight our battles on our behalf when we are weak. Exodus 14:14 and 2 Chronicles 20:15 says that God fights on our behalf. When we know that God is with us in the midst of our trying circumstances, we don't have to feel alone. We can be encouraged knowing that God is on our side and that He is readily available to meet us.

Greetings to my dear sisters in Christ. We are glad to meet you all through this newsletter, we pray that God will speak to you and encourage you through His word. This month we will madidate on the importance of God's word and the impact that our own words have on our lives.

1. God's word:

***“So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.”
- Isaiah 55:11***

The above verse is a promise of God written by Isaiah declaring God's faithfulness. The word which the Lord spoke to you will accomplish the purpose for which it was sent. God's word has the power to create new things in our lives. When the heavens and earth were without void and form, the Lord spoke His word and brought forth light. He created everything in heavens and earth through His word. He is the same God today who speaks His word in your lives. The situations might seem impossible, void and without form but the Lord is able to bring light in midst of the darkness. Bible says when we believe Him, God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did (Romans 4:17).

Bible says, the words the Jesus speak to us are Spirit and the Spirit gives us life (John 6:63). While it was already four days since Lazarus was dead, Jesus visiting his tomb spoke saying “Lazarus, come forth!”.



His word brought the dead man back to life (John 11:43). A woman who was bent over for eighteen years due to an infirmity was delivered through His word! God has the authority and power to accomplish His will in your life too. The same God who brought back Lazarus to life is with you today to revive the dead areas of your lives. The Lord who delivered the woman who was suffering for eighteen years is here to deliver you from your distress. Do you believe His word? When your situations seem grim and without hope put your trust on His word. For His word will never fail!

2. Our words:

***“Death and life are in the power of the tongue,
And those who love it will eat its fruit.” - Proverbs 18: 21***

There are several places in the bible where the Lord has instructed us to be watchful about what we speak. The above verse says our words have the power to bring life or death. Bible says the Lord was grieved because of the words of His children, Israelites (Numbers 14:11). The words we speak must please the Lord. When Moses sent twelve men to spy the land which the Lord their God had promised to give them, the words spoken by ten men caused fear and unbelief in the hearts of God’s children. The negative words which they spoke because of their unbelief became a snare for them. None of them were able to enter the promised land except Joshua and Caleb who brought them a good report about the land. Our words must be aligned to His will and purpose for our lives. When God gives us a promise, situations might not always seem conducive. In fact, it might be the opposite so we have to set our hearts on the Lord and speak His word in faith. Bible says the Word of the Lord that we speak is like a fire and a hammer that breaks the rock in pieces (Jeremiah 23:29). When we speak the word of God, it has the power to break the strongholds of the enemy in our lives. So, no matter how we feel or what we face today, let us be watchful to speak words of faith so we may see the fruit of His goodness in our lives.

“The Lord lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace.” - Numbers 6:26

The Lord wants to bless you this month with this promise verse. This verse is a blessing that the Lord instructed the Aaron and his sons to speak over the children of Israel. From the scriptures we can see that ‘peace’ is a blessing from God. But the enemy often tries to disturb this peace in us. In this message we are going to see about three women in the bible who received peace from God and learn what brought this blessing into their lives.

1. Sorrowful woman:

Then Eli answered and said, “Go in peace, and the God of Israel grant your petition which you have asked of Him.” - 1 Samuel 1:17

Here we see Eli, the priest blessing Hannah to ‘go in peace’. Hannah was in great distress because she did not have children so she poured out her heart to the Lord during her visit to the temple. Hannah prayed in her heart with only her mouth moving so Eli misunderstood her and reproved her because he thought she was drunk. But Hannah explained herself to him, he blessed her to go in peace. Eli did not know what exactly was the woman’s petition but he assured her because the Lord is a prayer answering God. Bible says “The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit” Psalm 34:18. During the time of our sorrow and brokenness, He does not leave us alone, He is the Lord Who walks with us and guides us in midst of our sorrow. Bible says that after this prayer, Hannah was no longer sorrowful. The peace that Hannah received came because of the assurance that God had listened to her prayer. According to her faith, the Lord remembered her and Hannah



conceived and bore a son (1 Samuel 1:20). After few years Hannah returned to the temple and met Eli with her son and said; “I am the woman who stood by you here, praying to the Lord. For this child I prayed, and the Lord has granted me my petition. Therefore, I also have lent him to the Lord; as long as he lives, he shall be lent to the Lord” (1 Samuel 1:26-28). Here we see how the Lord answered Hannah’s prayer.

Today in your lives too, if you are going through brokenness, God wants to comfort you and give you His peace that passes all understanding. Be assured that He is a prayer answering God, He will listen to your prayers and answer them just as He did for Hannah.

2. Sinful woman:

Then He said to the woman, “Your faith has saved you. Go in peace.” - Luke 7:50

Here we read of a woman who came to Jesus. Bible does not record her name but just mentions her as a sinful woman. She came to Jesus when He was invited by a Pharisees to eat. Bible says she stood at His feet behind Him weeping; and she began to wash His feet with her tears. Like Hannah this woman also went through brokenness but her brokenness was a result of her sin. In midst of her brokenness, she came to the right person; her savior. The name Jesus means, He will save us from our sins (Matthew 1:21). This woman reached out to Him and received His forgiveness because she understood the mercy of God and His great power to deliver her from the clutches of sin (Ephesians 1:7). Jesus had compassion on her and said to her “your sins are forgiven”. Not only that He also blessed her to ‘go in peace’. An assurance of forgiveness for her sins brought peace in this woman’s life. Because she came to

Jesus, believed Him and loved Him, her life was rebuilt. Jesus helped her to be cleansed from her past sins and begin a new life!

As children of God when we go through guilt because of sins most of us don't reach out to God. Whenever you are going through regrets or feel guilty just reach out to Jesus, He is able to restore your life. He is the only person who can forgive you and give you peace.

***“Israel, put your hope in the Lord,
for with the Lord is unfailing love and with him is full redemption.
He himself will redeem Israel from all their sins.” - Psalm 130:7,8***

3. Sick woman:

***And He said to her, “Daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has made you well.
Go in peace.” Luke 8:48***

Above verse was spoken by Jesus to a woman who had issue of blood. In Old Testament times such woman was not allowed to come out to a public gathering. However, this woman took a bold step in faith desiring just to touch the hem of Jesus' garment so that she could be healed. But when she was called by Jesus in front of all



those who had gathered there, she was frightened. She came to Jesus with fear of what He would say to her. She was in fear because of all the people who had been gathered around Jesus but Jesus comforted her saying “daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has made you well. Go in peace.” This woman was blessed with peace because of the power of God that touched her life. Although there were many people who were gathered around Jesus, she received the power of God because of her faith. Bible says that this woman had been suffering for twelve years and had spent all her livelihood on physicians. By the power of God, she was healed not only in her body but was also blessed with peace. If you are facing a struggle in your life and no one is able to help you, come to Jesus. There is power in the presence of the Lord. When we reach out to Him in faith, He is able to touch us and bless us in the way He blessed this woman.

And Abraham called the name of the place, The-Lord-Will-Provide as it is said to this day, "In the Mount of the Lord it shall be provided."

Genesis 22:14

Abraham was one hundred years old when Isaac was born according to the promise (Genesis 17:7). Abraham and his family were joyful of the birth of Isaac. After some time, God determined to test the faith of Abraham, saying: "Take your son, your only son Isaac whom you love and go to the land of Moriah and offer him there as a burnt offering" (Genesis 22:2). It was a great challenge for Abraham, but he knew in his heart that He who promised me is faithful to keep His promise. So, he obeyed God. He saddled his donkey took his son, servants, and wood for the burnt offering and he began his journey. Abraham showed his faith through his words again and again. When he spoke to his servants he said: "I and the boy will go over the mount Moriah and worship and we will come back to you" (Genesis 22:5)

Then, the second time, when Isaac asked his father "where is the lamb for offering"? (Genesis 22:7). Abraham replied, "God will provide for Himself the lamb". Abraham acknowledged here that God is his provider, and He will take care of everything. After that, Abraham built an altar and bound his son Isaac and took a knife to slay his son. But the angel of the Lord stopped him and provided a ram for his of-

Abraham had confessed through his mouth.

When you have received a promise from God, please, confess like Abraham with your mouth again and again do not look at the outside circumstances.




